

Sāib ibn Yazid relates: When the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, returned from the battle of Tabook, people went out from Medina to meet him and I also met him with other boys at Tahniyat-il-Wada'. (Sunan Abi Dawūd 2779, Book 15, Hadith 303)

Promise of Second Manifestation



Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih V, may Allah be his helper

So dear friends! Since it is the Divine Trait, from time immemorial, that God Almighty shows two Manifestations so that the two false joys of the opponents be put to an end, it is not possible now that God should relinquish His Trait of old. ... It is essential for you to witness the second Manifestation also, and its coming is better for you because it is everlasting, the continuity of which will not end till the Day of Judgement.

And that second Manifestation cannot come unless I depart. But when I depart, God will send that second Manifestation for you which shall always stay with you just as promised by God in Barahīn-e-Aḥmadiyya. And this promise is not for my person. Rather the promise is with reference to you, as God [addressing me] says: I shall make this Jamā'at who are your followers, prevail over others till the Day of Judgment. Thus, it is inevitable that you see the

day of my departure, so that after that day the day comes which is the day of ever-lasting promise.

Our God is He Who keeps His promise and is Faithful and is the Truthful God. He shall show you all that He has promised. Though these days are the last days of this world and there are many a disaster waiting to happen, yet it is necessary that this world continues to exist until all those things about which God has prophesied come to pass. I came from God as a Manifestation of Divine Providence and I am a personification of His Power. And after I am gone there will be some other persons who will be the manifestation of the second Power [of God]. So, while waiting for the second Manifestation of His Power, you all together keep yourselves busy praying. And let a Jama'at of righteous people, one and all, in every country keep themselves busy in prayers so that the second Manifestation may descend from the Heaven and show you that your God is such Mighty God. Consider your death to be close at hand for you never know when that hour will strike.

Let the righteous persons of the Jama'at who have pure souls accept Bai'at in my name. God Almighty desires to draw all those who live in various habitations of the world, be it Europe or Asia, and who have virtuous nature, to the Unity of God and unite His servants under one Faith. This indeed is the purpose of God for which I have been sent to the world. You, too, therefore, pursue this end, but with kindness, moral probity and fervent prayers. And till that time when someone inspired by God with the Holy Spirit is raised by Him, all of you work in harmony with one another.

And you, too, partake of the Holy Spirit by compassion and by purifying your souls. Because without the Holy Spirit true Taqwa cannot be attained. And, totally shedding all base desires of the self, choose for the sake of winning the pleasure of God that path compared to which no path can be narrower and straiter. Don't fall in love with the pleasures of the world, for they take you away from God. Choose a life of austerity for the sake of God. ⁱ Such persons will be selected by consensus of the believers. Hence if forty believers agree that a person is competent to accept Bai'at in my name, he will be entitled to accept Bai'at. And such a person ought to make himself an example for others. God has informed me: "I shall raise for thy Jamā'at one from thy progeny and shall honor him with My revelation and nearness. Truth will flourish through him and a large number of people accept him." So, wait for those days. And you should remember that one is recognized only when one's time comes. And it is possible that before such a time one may appear to be an ordinary person; or because of some deceptive thoughts, one may even be regarded as objectionable; just as one who is destined to be perfect, is at one time, only a drop of semen or clot of blood in the womb. Selected Events of Hadrat Khalifat-ul-Masīķ V^{aba} Since August 2018

August-December, 2018

3-5 August 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed 52nd Jalsa Salana UK and delivered inaugural, second day and concluding addresses. More than 647,000 people joined the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.

9 September 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed Jalsa Salana Germany.

15-16 September 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed inaugural and concluding sessions of 25th Jalsa Salana, Belgium. He also addressed Lajna Ima'illah on 15 September 2018.

23 September 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed concluding session of Ijtima of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya, UK.

30 September 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed concluding session Ansarullah's Ijtima UK. He also delivered concluding address at Lajna UK Ijtima.

October-November 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V toured USA for the fourth time. (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, September-October 2018 p. 20). To honor the historic visit of Mirza Mansoor Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih V, nineteen members of the US Congress co-sponsored a bipartisan resolution No. 1125 before the House of Representatives.

16 October 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V inspected MTA international's Masroor Teleport which has been recently redeveloped. He concluded the event with a silent prayer. (alislam.org/press-release/2018-arrival-USA/)

19 October 2018: Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad inaugurated Bait-ul-Aafiyat and later delivered Friday sermon from there. (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, p. 208) (Friday sermon dated 19 October 2018)

19 October 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered the keynote address at a special reception held to mark the inauguration of the "Baitul Aafiyat" (House of Security) mosque in Philadelphia, USA. He traveled to Central America for the first time. He said: The mosque will prove a beacon of light to all peace-loving people. Over 175 dignitaries and guests attended. (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, pp. 208-210) (Friday sermon dated 19 October 2018), (alislam.org/press-release/2018arrival-USA/) 20 October 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V inaugurated the Baitus Samad Ahmadiyya mosque in Baltimore, USA. A special reception was arranged at Hilton Hotel, Baltimore where 500 guests attended. He said, "True mosques were centers of peace, where Muslims joined together in order to worship God Almighty and to serve humanity, irrespective of faith or belief." (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, pp. 211-215) (Friday sermon dated 19 October 2018), Hazrat Mirza Mansoor Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih V went to the *Laurel Hill Cemetery* Philadelphia and prayed at the grave of Dr George Baker, a pioneer Ahmadi Muslim of the US Jamā'at. (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, p. 216), (Tour of USA and Guatemala October-November 2018 by Abid Khan)

23 October 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V inaugurated Nasir Hospital in Sacatepéquez Guatemala. This is the state of art hospital built by Humanity First. Eight Hundred dignitaries and guests from twenty countries attended the reception. He said, "We seek no praise and reward for our humanitarian efforts because we are merely doing what our religion has taught us to do." He also launched the first ever edition of Review of Religions magazine in Spanish language. [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, pp. 217-220 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)]

26 October 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered Friday sermon from Baitus Samee Houston, TX for the first time. He stressed the need to adopt the highest standards of righteousness as explained by the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him). [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, pp. 221-222 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)], (Tour of USA and Guatemala October-November 2018 by Abid Khan)

30 October 2018: Khalifa of Jamā'at Ahmadiyya International visited Joppa Town. He inspected the housing complex initiated by Majlis Ansarullah USA. [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, pp. 218 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)], (Tour of USA and Guatemala October-November 2018 by Abid Khan) and (The Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, March -April 2019)

2 November 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered Friday sermon from Bait-ur-Rahman Mosque, Maryland (National Headquarters of Jamā'at Ahmadiyya community in the USA). After Friday prayer, he led a Bai'at ceremony in which around 8000 people took part. [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, p. 223 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)]

3 November 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V was welcomed by US Congressman Gerry Connolly at the inauguration reception of Masroor Mosque in Virginia. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V inaugurated Masroor Mosque in Manassas, South Virginia. The church building was procured in 2018. US congressman Gerry Connolly welcomed His Holiness Mirza Masroor Ahmad. A reception was arranged. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered keynote address. [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, p. 224 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)]

5 November 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered Friday sermon at Bait-ur-Rahman, Maryland. To honor the historic U.S. visit of Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V, nineteen members of the U.S. Congress co-sponsored a bi-partisan resolution 1125 before the U.S. House of Representatives. Delivered his weekly Friday Sermon from the Baitur Rahman Mosque, Maryland on 5 November 2018, which serves as the National Headquarters of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community in the United States. (Tour of USA and Guatemala October-November 2018 by Abid Khan)

30 December 2018: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V delivered concluding address at 124th Jalsa Salana Qadian.

Year 2019

20 January 2019: : Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed Ahmadiyya Board of Arbitration's Centenary International Refresher Course.

6 February 2020: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V sent a special message on the completion of 100 years of Jamā'at Ahmadiyya, USA. He said: "These centennial days should not be just to celebrate the past hundred years, but to devote yourself in spreading the teaching and message of Ahmadiyyat with a renewed zeal, and to rejuvenate the enthusiasm and spirit of Hazrat Mufti Muhammad Sadiq to find the righteous souls, so that as the Jamā'at expands there in future, the arrangements for their education and training also fall in place." [Ahmadiyya Gazette USA, April-September 2020, p. 1 (comprising Hundred Years of Ahmadiyya Islam in the US)]

6 April 2019: Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih V addressed the concluding session of the UK National Wāqifāt-e-Nau Ijtima at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London. It was attended by 1100 women and girls.

7April 2019: Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul-Masih V addressed the concluding session of the UK National Waqf-e-Nau Ijtima at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London. It was attended by 1700 members, including just fewer than 1400 members from Waqf-e-Nau scheme.

15 April 2019: History was made when the World Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, the Fifth Khalifa (Caliph), His Holiness Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad departed from the Fazl Mosque shortly after 6 pm and travelled directly to Islamabad where he arrived at 6.55 pm and was greeted by hundreds of Ahmadi Muslim men, women and children, all overjoyed to welcome their spiritual leader to the new headquarters.

27 April 2019: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed concluding session of IAAAE (International Association of Ahmadi Architect and Engineers) Annual Symposium which was held at Bait-ul-Futūh Mosque in south-west London.

29 April 2019: The 7th Convocation Ceremony for Jāmi'a Ahmadiyya UK, the 8th Convocation Ceremony for Jāmi'a Ahmadiyya Canada and the 4th Convocation Ceremony for Jāmi'a Ahmadiyya Germany took place in a combined event at the UK college premises in Haslemere, Surrey. Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (may Allah be his Helper) presided over the ceremony and delivered the keynote address.

17 May 2019: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V opened new central mosque (Mubarak Mosque) in Islamabad, Tilford, UK.

7 July 2019: The World Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, the Fifth Khalifa (Caliph), His Holiness, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad concluded the 44th Annual Convention (Jalsa Salana) of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community in Germany with an inspirational address.

12-14 July 2019: The seventy-first Annual Convention of Ahmadiyya Community USA was held at Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex Harrisburg. The attendance recorded was 9200. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V sent a message on seventy-first Annual Convention of Ahmadiyya Community in Islam. More than 9000 attended the convention while 25000 listened the proceeding online. (Al-Hakam, 19 July 2019)

2-4 August 2019: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed (Inaugural, Lajna Address on second day, second day address and concluding address) at Annual Convention of Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, UK.

8 September 2019: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed the concluding session of 3-day Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya UK Ijtima. 6100 attended.

15 September 2019: Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V addressed the annual gathering of Lajna Ima'illa UK.

delivered inaugural and concluding address at the 39th Annual Convention of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community in Nunspeet, Holland.

1 October 2019: Khalifatul-Masih V inaugurated the Baitul Aafiyat Mosque in Almere, Holland.







Notes on chapters and verses of the Holy Qur'ān by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV^{rh}

— Surah Al-Anbiya to Surah Al-Hajj —

(Continued from previous issues)

21. Al-Anbiya: Introduction

This is a Meccan Surah, and its revelation period is the fourth or fifth year of the Call. Including Basmallah, it consists of one hundred and thirteen verses.

About the reckoning of people mentioned at the end of the preceding Surah and that it would become manifest to you that it is you who are on the right path; in the beginning of the current Surah, it has been stated that time of reckoning has arrived, but most people are unmindful of it.

Next, it was stated in this Surah that We sent none as Messengers before you but men, and they were not given bodies that lived without food. Here implicatively the Divinity of Hazrat Jesus^{as} has been refuted, as he had been taking food throughout the life.

Immediately after this was stated that ignorant people have taken gods from the earth; and presented a wonderful argument on this that the existence of two Gods is impossible. Had it been possible both the heavens and earth would have gone to ruin? Every God would have taken his creation and set aside; and the universe would have been hampered and ruined to such an extent that it could never have been repaired. Whereas look wherever one may they will not find any sign of disunion in it. That is why it was said that We have been sending revelation that "There is none worthy of worship except the One God" to all those Prophets as well that were sent before this one.

Verse number 27 mentions their false claim that Allah the Almighty has taken a son. But whenever a hypothetical son is deified, it fails to stop there and many more are added to this hypothesis. Therefore, immediately thereafter it was said that there are many more holy men of God like Hazrat Jesus^{as} who have been associated as partners of Allah.

Immediately thereafter is mentioned a verse which unveils such secrets of the universe which were beyond the imagination of man of that age. It said: the entire universe was a tightly closed-up mass like a ball out of which nothing could come out. Then We opened it out and the entire universe popped up, and with water every living thing was created. And immediately after water, the cycle of water associated with firm mountains was mentioned. It was also mentioned as to how the heavens protect the earth and its inhabitants; next was mentioned the perpetual circulation of the heavens and earth and all heavenly bodies; and as the heavens and earth are not ever-lasting, it was pointed out that man, too, is not going to live forever. And, O Prophet! None of the people that lived before you has lived eternally.

Thereafter are mentioned all the Prophets that came before the Holy Prophet^{sa} that how Allah the Almighty delivered munificence of His Graciousness to them. It also discussed the inviolable subject that once the dwellers of a town are destroyed, they never come back to it again; so much so that even in the time of Gog and Magog, when seemingly the scientists will claim to revive the dead, it would not be possible.

Further, ahead in the Surah, the mention of the rolling up of the heavens is found, and also said that it would not be done for eternal, rather from the very universe, which would once go into non-existence, a new universe would be created. Allah the Almighty has the power to repeat this process.

In the last Ruku' of the Surah; Allah the Almighty, declared the Holy Prophet^{sa} a manifestation of the Gracious God for the entire world, and stated that We have sent you, too, as a mercy for the whole world.

In the final verse of the Surah, the Holy Prophet^{sa} prays to his Lord to judge between him and the disbelievers with the truth. As he is the representative of the Gracious, he warns the entire world that the Gracious God will not abandon this servant of His who is a manifestation of His Graciousness for the whole world.

Next comes Surah Al-Hajj which is a perfect proof of the fact that the Holy Prophet^{sa} was sent for the entire world as Rahmat ul-Lil-'Ālamīn. And Baitullah (the Hose of Allah) is the only place where mankind assembles from all around the world to perform the Hajj.

Notes: Al-Anbiya'

Verse 9

وَمَا جَعَلْنَاهُمْ جَسَدًا لاَ يَأْكُلُونَ الطَّعَامَ وَمَا كَانُوا خَالِدِينَ

This verse makes it clear that not a single Prophet has been in the world who lived without taking food. Thus, any Prophet who had been taking food has not enjoyed an unnatural long life.

Verse 35

Addressing the Holy Prophet^{sa}, it states that no Prophet before you have been granted an unnatural long life. How is it possible that you should die whereas others live an unnatural long life? This verse conclusively proves the death of Hazrat Jesus^{as} as well.

Verse 64

قَالَ بَلْ فَعَلَهُ كَبِيرُهُمْ هَذَا فَاسْأَلُوهُمْ إِنْ كَانُوا يَنطِقُونَ

It is suggested to give a pause after بَلْ فَعَلَهُ (*bal fa'alahu*) in this verse, so as to be concluded that someone else did it. But in my point of view there is absolutely no such need for this; because Hazrat Abraham^{as} himself had informed them that he was going to do something to their deities. So, this is not a lie. Rather, to present something impossible as possible is a style of argument, which was granted particularly to Hazrat Abraham^{as}. Not a single one among his opponents conceded that the bigger idol killed all the other ones. And to take it as an impossibility proves the falsity of their belief that their deities have some power.

Verse 70

قُلْنَا يَا نَارُ كُونِي بَرْدًا وَسَلاَمًا عَلَى إبْرَاهِيمَ

Here "fire" signifies the fire of opposition, and it may also stand for real fire. In the present age the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) received a revelation "Do not threaten me with fire, for the fire is my servant, rather servant of my servants" (*Arba'īn Number 3, Rūḥānī* *Khazā'in*, Vol. 17, p. 429). Getting cooled down of the fire means that its heat will not be enabled to destroy, rather the fire itself will cool down.

Verse 80

Here the subjection of the mountains means that mountainous people were subjected to him. Similarly, the mention of the army of birds is found in the army of Hazrat Solomon^{as}. This too is a metaphor. It has two meanings. (1) Those people who were spiritually enabled to soar away; (2) and the swift cavalryman who, like birds, quickly reached from one place to the other. And the fastest cavalry in the army of Hazrat Solomon^{as} has been termed as the army of birds.

Verse 82

The subjection of winds to Hazrat Solomon^{as} means that in the coastal area of Palestine the winds would change their direction after a month and thus the ships of Hazrat Solomon^{as} sailed because of those winds. And after a month the winds would change their direction to the opposite side.

Verse 83

Here the word شَيَّاطِين (Shaya teen) does not signify the Satans made of fire; otherwise, this fire would have died down because of diving into the seas. It signifies rebellious people who were subjected by Hazrat Solomon^{as}; some of them were divers.

Verse 88

When Hazrat Jonah^{as} saw that his warning prophecy was not fulfilled, and because he was unaware that the warning prophecies are put in abeyance after crying and wailing, in anger he headed towards the sea, where a whale initially devoured him and later vomited him out alive. In this time of darkness, he supplicated the following prayer from the heart that O Lord! There is no God but Thou, Holy are Thou. I have indeed been of the wrongdoers.

Verses 96-97

In these verses township stands for the people of the township. Once a people are destroyed, they do not return back to the world. The word خَتَّى (even when) does not signify that the dead peoples will come back in the time of Gog and Magog. Rather it means that even in the time of Gog and Magog the dead will not be able to come back. Superficially they play tricks as if they have quickened the dead, but they can never quicken the real dead.

Verse 106

It is a reference to the prophecy of Hazrat David^{as} mentioned in Psalms chapter 37.

22. Al-Hajj: Introduction

This is a Medinite Surah, and including *Basmallah* it consists of seventy-nine verses. All human beings have been warned of the earthquake of the Hour in the first verse of the Surah; because the Messenger that came had invited all human beings to come under the protection of the Gracious God. As a result of the rejection of the invitation the warning of such terrible wars is being given as if the entire earth would be destroyed. It would be such a terrible destruction that the mothers would forget to take care of their suckling's; and every pregnant woman would miscarry; and you shall see men as they were drunken, while they will not be drunken. Because of the severe chastisement from Allah, they would lose their senses.

One may think of the Judgment Day as to how will all human beings be revived once they are all dead. It is said that Allah Who created you from dust earlier, and passed you through various stages in the womb of your mother, shall revive you.

Next, it is said that there are those among people who worship Allah as if they are on the verge of a pit. As long as good befalls them they are content with it; and when there befalls them a trial, they fall into it upside down. Such people are in loss in this world as well as Hereafter.

Next, briefly are discussed the followers of all the religions that Allah would judge between them on the Day of Resurrection.

Next, Allah the Almighty commands emphatically not to hinder those from the Sacred Mosque who come for the Hajj

(pilgrimage) of the House of Allah. Immediately thereafter is mentioned the House of Allah and the directive given to Hazrat Abraham^{as} to always keep the House of Allah clean for those who perform the Hajj and circuits. The directive given to Hazrat Abraham^{as} was not confined to his person only; but this directive is for his followers as well as the followers of the Holy Prophet^{sa} until the Day of Judgment.

Next, the Holy Prophet^{sa} has been commanded to give an open invitation to all mankind to come to the Sacred Mosque for Hajj. Next was discussed the sacrifices etc. that they, too, like the Sacred House, are included in the sacred Signs of Allah. Desecration of those signs would be tantamount to desecrating the Sacred House. But the animals sacrificed for the sake of the Sacred House would be acceptable only when they are offered with righteousness. Because their flesh reaches not Allah the Almighty, nor does their blood; but only the righteousness of the person offering the sacrifice reaches Allah.

Next, in detail light has been shed on the subject of Jihad with sword. And it was said that permission to take up arms in defense is given to those against whom war is made by their opponents, and they have been driven out from their houses only because they said, "Our Lord is Allah." The wonderful subject was also raised that if defensive measures had not been allowed then there was no guarantee of the security of the mosques of Muslims only, rather the synagogues and churches etc. and cloisters would also be destroyed.

Next, referring to the destruction of the disbelieving peoples of the past Prophets it was pointed out that if man is to visit the land and with open eyes try to find out the buried traces of the destroyed people, surely, he would get awareness of the evil end of those peoples. These days the archaeologists are working on it and they have succeeded in discovering buried traces of a number of past peoples.

Thereafter, it was said in verse 53 that in case any desire of heart is combined with the desires of a Prophet then Allah the Almighty removes that desire through the Divine revelation. The Satan referred to at this point does not stand for the accursed Satan, but it refers to the Satan running with the flow of blood in man. And the Holy Prophet^{sa} said: *Wa lakinn Allah A'anani alaihi fa aslama (Musnad Ahmad bin Hanbal, Musnad Bani Hashim*), that Allah the Almighty helped me against him and he has become a Muslim. Thus, this verse in no way means that in reality a Satan inspires the hearts of Prophets; because, at another place (As-Shu'ara 222-223) it has very clearly been explained that the Satan is not allowed to come closer to the Prophets. It descends on very lying sinners. And this statement does in no way apply to the Prophets.

In the last *Ruku'* of the Surah it was stated that those so-called Partners on whom they call upon beside of Allah are not capable to recover anything from the mouth of a fly if it licks anything. In reality the moment anything enters the mouth of a fly, as a result of its saliva and chemical changes in its belly, it does not remain in its original state anymore.

Striving in the cause of Allah has been admonished in the final verse of the Surah, which has already been explained. It was also stated that Hazrat Abraham^{as}, the Holy Prophet^{sa} and their followers have been named Muslims by Allah. He knows the best as to who completely submits before Him.

Finally, the announcement has been repeated that this Messenger i.e., Muhammad^{sa} is a universal Messenger.

Verse 6



The foremost worth-mentioning point in this verse is that all the stages of human evolution have been discussed in it. So much so that the changes that take place in fetus in the belly of the mother have been related in the same order as the scientists have discovered in the present age. This verse is a conclusive proof of the fact that the Holy Prophet^{sa} had no personal knowledge of such things and none else save the Omniscient God could have provided this information to him. Further ahead the verse states that Allah granted life to earth by showering water on dry soil. This is a wonderful and remarkable discovery that according to the scientists when water showers on dry soil, in reality the signs of life appear in it. In fact, here it refers to the point that the heavenly water that showered on the Holy Prophet^{sa} has revived a dead land, i.e., spiritually dead people.

Verse 76

A Divine practice has been presented as a rule in this verse, whose cessation has not been mentioned at all. That is, Allah the Almighty always chooses His Messengers from among angels or from among men.

Verse 79




The first point to reflect in the verse is that no one has proprietary rights over the word "Muslim." Allah the Almighty declared Hazrat Abraham^{as} and his followers as Muslims much before the advent of Islam.

Next, it is mentioned that the Holy Prophet^{sa} is a witness, i.e., a guardian, over all the Muslims; and the



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Muslims are a witness over all the other peoples. The sense in which the Holy Prophet^{sa}, in his time, was a witness, exactly in the same sense, following in his footsteps, the Muslims are a witness over others. Being a witness does not signify to coerce others to become the type of Muslims one likes. Because being a witness as well the Holy Prophet^{sa} never fought a war of aggression, nor did he coerce anyone to become a Muslim.



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
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
