Commentary:


The ears and eyes of the guilty will bear witness against them in three ways:

- (1) The evil consequences of the actions of disbelievers will take physical form in the next world and thus will be quite apparent for anyone to see.
- (2) The very organs of the bodies of disbelievers having been vitiated by misuse, their vitiate condition will bear witness against them; and
- (3) The words uttered by them and all the movement of the organs of their bodies, having been preserved, will be reproduced on the Last Day.

Commentary by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (may Allah shower His mercy on him):

The foremost of the testimonies against the criminals on the Day of Judgment, laid down in these verses (21-23), is surprisingly the testimony of skin. The testimony of skin was unfathomable in that age; but in the current age anthropologists have conclusively proven that external and internal features of a human being have been stamped, most of all, in every cell of the skin. So much so that if an animal, died millions of years before, is buried in such a way that its skin cells are preserved, only a single cell of those can be used to recreate exactly the same animal. The procedure of creation of sheep or humans by skin cells through genetic engineering also proves this very Quranic testimony. The Messenger of Allah, may peace and blessings of Allah be on him, said: "Whoever sends blessings upon me once, Allah will send blessings upon him tenfold and will erase from him ten misdeeds and raise him ten degrees in status." Sunan al-Nasa'i (1297), the Book of Forgetfulness (in Prayer)

The Holy Prophet heard a person supplicating during a prayer. He neither mentioned the greatness of Allah nor prayed for blessings on the Holy Prophet. The Prophet said that he did his prayers in haste. The Prophet then called him and said or said to someone else, "If any of you pray, he should start mentioning the praise of Allah and then pray for blessings on the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Then he should ask Allah anything." (Sunan Abi Dāwud 1481, Kitab Al-Salāt, detail about Witr. Translated from Urdu by the Editor of the Ahmadiyya Gazette Online, USA)





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The revelation that was sent to the Promised Messiah (peace be on him) regarding Darūd Sharif (Salat 'Alan-Nabi, praying for blessing for the Holy Prophet) is as follows:

["Call down blessings on Muhammad, may peace and blessings of Allah be on him, and the people of Muhammad. Calling down blessings is the true training. I [God] shall raise you towards Me and bestow My nearness upon you. And I have conferred My own love upon you." (Barahīn-e- Ahmadiyya, Part III [English], p. 212)]

The Promised Messiah (peace be on him) further said:

"By invoking Darūd (praying for blessings) on the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him), one can attain the status of Prophet Jesus (peace be on him) and even the rank of Prophet Moses (peace be on him), and God will prove this through the person of the Promised Messiah (peace be on him)." (Barāhīne-Ahmadiyya, Part III [English], p. 175)

The Promised Messiah, peace be on him, says:

"On one occasion it so happened that I remained very much occupied with calling down blessings on the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, for a long time, for I believed that the ways leading to God are very fine and cannot be discovered except through the agency of the Holy Prophet, as Allah says too,

وَابْتَغُوًّا إِلَيْهِ الْوَسِيْلَةَ

[And seek the way of approach unto Him, Surah al-Ma'idah, 5:36]. After a time, I saw, in a vision, that two water carriers came and entered into my house, one by the outer entrance and the other by the inner entrance carrying on their shoulders waterskins full of divine light and they said:

[This is on account of the blessings you invoked upon Muhammad]."

May Allah support him with His mighty help.

1 December 2023

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) continued to narrate incidents that happened during the battles. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih said that he would speak about the character of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) at the Battle of Uhud. The Quraish army departed from Mecca under the leadership of Abu Sufyan with three thousand soldiers. They included Hind, the wife of Abu Sufyan, who was able to convince the men to allow women to accompany them, and as such, it is recorded that fifteen women accompanied the army. The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) consulted with the

8 December 2023

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) continued to describe events that happened before the Battle of Uhud. The Holy Prophet's opinion was that they should remain in Madina and attack from there. But young companions who had not taken part in the Battle of Badr due to their age were eager to go out and fight. The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) advised his companions to remain patient and they would come out victorious. The people went to the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) and said that their intention had not been to oppose his opinion, and if he felt that they should remain in Madina then they would remain in Madina. The Holy Prophet responded that it did not behoove a prophet to remove his armor until God had decided between him and the enemy. On reaching Uhud, Abdullah bin Ubay bin Salol, chief of the hypocrites betrayed the Muslims by

Companions about this battle and it was agreed to fight the enemy out of Madina.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V urged to continue prayers for the Palestinians. He said that after the pause in fighting, there will be indiscriminate bombardment upon them once again, as a result of which more innocent people will lose their lives. What will be the extent of this cruelty? Only Allah knows the best. The intentions of the greater powers for them are very dangerous. Hence, we must pray a great deal for them, that Allah the Almighty has mercy on them.

separating himself from three hundred followers and returned to Madina. Only 700 Muslim souls had to fight 3000 warriors of Quresh. The Holy Prophet enjoined the Muslims to adhere to the commandments revealed by God and abstain from that which He has forbidden. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V said that he would continue the details of the battle.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V urged continued prayers for the Palestinians. In recent days, after the pause in fighting ended, exactly what was expected is taking place now. The Israeli government is bombarding and attacking every part of Gaza with even greater force than before. More innocent children are being martyred. Now, even a Jewish representative of Congress in the United States has said enough is enough.

15 December 2023

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) narrated the incident of the Battle of Uhud. The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) stationed 50 archers on the mountain from where the enemy could attack and instructed archers not to leave there under any circumstances until instructed by him. On the day of Uhud, the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) held a sword and asked who would take it. All the Companions expressed their willingness. The Holy Prophet again asked, saying who would do justice to it? Upon this the Companions became silent, however, Hazrat Abu Dujanah (may Allah be pleased with him) spoke up and said he would do justice

22 December 2023

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) narrated incidents during the Battle of Uhud. During the battle, the disbelievers suffered great loss at the hands of the Muslims and they were forced to flee. However, despite the Holy Prophet's (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) instructions, most of the Companions stationed upon the hill left their post, causing the Muslims to endure great loss. Upon seeing the disbelievers flee, the Muslims went after them, and in their hastiness, despite calls not to, many archers on the hill also went after the disbelievers. Many historians have commented that the hastiness of these Companions was due to their desire to obtain the spoils of war. However, it does not seem accurate to assert this regarding the Companions of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V explained why some companions left their posts on the hill. The Companions were ready to sacrifice anything and everything they had for the sake of Islam and the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him), when they had already given everything, they had, and they even desired the station of martyrdom then it cannot be said that the Companions were chasing after the spoils of war. These wars were not fought for the sake of spoils, rather the spoils would be a secondary result of the battle. Hence, it does not seem accurate to say that the Companions left the hill out of their desire to hastily seek spoils. Rather, it seems more likely that upon seeing the disbelievers flee, they assumed a certain victorious end to the battle. Or, they saw that their brothers were engaged in face-to-face combat and sought to partake. However, their appointed leader Hazrat Abdullah bin

29 December 2023

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) continued to narrate incidents during the Battle of Uhud. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V said: That upon the Muslims abandoning their station on the mound, the disbelievers

to it. Thereafter, he wreaked great havoc against the enemy using that very sword, thereby doing justice to it. The Muslims won the battle.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) urged continuous prayers for the Palestinians. The cruelties are exceeding all bounds and increasing by the day. May Allah bring the oppressors to task and create ease for the oppressed Palestinians. May he grant the Muslim countries reason and understanding that they must unite as one voice so that they may be those who strive to uphold the rights of their Muslim brethren.

Jubair (may Allah be pleased with him), was calling out to them to remain in their posts.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) also described the martyrdom of Hazrat Hamzah (may Allah be pleased with him), the paternal uncle and foster brother of the Holy Prophet. He fought valiantly in the battle. His body was mutilated, and his liver was extracted and taken to Hind (the wife of an enemy leader) who chewed it. It saddened the Holy Prophet. The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) said that the angel Gabriel came and informed him that Hazrat Hamzah (may Allah be pleased with him) had been recorded in the seven heavens as being a lion.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) asked for prayers for Palestinians. The war is continuing. Although more voices are being raised and people say that injustices are being perpetrated, however, it seems that everyone is afraid of the Israeli government. Either that, or the Western world is naturally against the Muslim world and harbors hatred against them, due to which they do not wish for the injustices against them to end, or are not taking the necessary actions to bring the injustices to an end. They do not consider that these injustices are being perpetrated against innocent children, women, and the elderly. Hence, we cannot fully trust them, however, we must continue striving to help them understand and we must also continue to pray. May Allah enable the Muslim world to bolster its voice so that they may raise their voices and bring an end to these injustices. (Summary adapted from the Review of Religions)

launched a fierce attack from the rear. However, even in this frantic state, the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) remained steadfast and patient. He would call out to the companions hearkening them to return to the battlefield and fight. In the fray, the Holy Prophet was stuck by rocks and fell unconscious. The false news spread that God forbid the Holy Prophet had been martyred. In the battle, the Muslims suffered a great loss which could have been avoided had the Muslims adhered to the instructions of the Holy Prophet. The Prophet of Allah remained firm and did not take a single step backward, rather he constantly shot arrows.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) led the funeral prayer of Dr. Muhammad Jalal Shams who was serving as a missionary. (He was the father of Atiya-tul-Haye Malik and father-in-law of Jawad Ahmad Malik of Silver Spring, serving as Audio Video Secretary of Maryland Jamā'at). Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih said:

He was a very capable, intelligent, and simple life devotee, who recently passed away. He initially served at various places in Pakistan. Then, upon the instruction of the third Caliph(may Allah shower His mercy on him), he studied the Turkish language in Islamabad. He was then sent to Turkey for higher education in the Turkish language, where he obtained his PhD in the Turkish language. Then, upon the instruction of the Fourth Caliph (may Allah shower His mercy on him), he served as a missionary in the UK and Germany. As such, he knew many people from Turkey, the UK, and Germany, and they have been writing about him. He was later appointed as the in charge of the Turkish Desk in the UK,

in which role he served until his demise. He was blessed with great intelligence. He was even offered a job by the university in Istanbul; it was a good job with excellent compensation. When he received the offer, he sought guidance from the Fourth Caliph (may Allah shower His mercy on him) about what he should do. The Fourth Caliph advised that he should decide after prayers and careful consideration. Upon doing so, he decided to give precedence to his life devotion, and he turned down the offer. In 2002, he was imprisoned in Turkey for four months because of preaching the message of Islam Ahmadiyya. He helped translate the Holy Qur'an into Turkish, along with translating dozens of other books, including those of the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) into Turkish. He was extremely intellectual and loved to read, both literature of the Community and other literature as well. He was very humble and despite his esteemed knowledge, he was not too proud to seek help from even junior missionaries. He knew various languages. He also used to translate the Friday Sermon. Turkish natives would express how impressed they were with his mastery of the Turkish language. He had a great deal of love for the Caliphate. He would see true dreams. He would always remain occupied in the remembrance of Allah. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) prayed that may Allah elevate his station, grant his wife and children patience, and enable them to carry on the legacy of his virtues.

Allah helps those who work hard

National Amila of Trinidad and Tobago meets with Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V



On 26 November 2023, the national Amila of Trinidad and Tobago had the opportunity to meet Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) in a virtual

Mulagat.

National Amila members introduced the departments and tasks they were given and provided a

brief background of what had been accomplished.

Hassan Hussein was the first to present his report, in which he said

he was serving as Naib Amir, Secretary Wasaya, and Auditor. Hearing this, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) smiled and said, "So, you are holding all the portfolios."

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) asked, "How many Amila members are Musi and asked them to raise their hands." Apart from these Amila members, you only have three other members who are Musi," Khalifatul-Masih V said.

Alluding to the Amila members, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) said that they should all do waṣiyyat. "If they do waṣiyyat, it means 33% of your earning members will be Musi [...]."

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V emphasized, "Organize your system properly."

Aman Muhammad reported that he was both the Secretary for the Ta'lim department and the Tarbiyat department.

He reported that he was holding online classes. Hearing this, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) said, "You are confusing your Ta'lim department with the auxiliary organization's Ta'lim department. There is a difference," Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) explained, "between the Ta'lim department of the Jamā'at and the auxiliary organizations. Here, in the Jamā'at, the Ta'lim department's job is to keep the data of all the students going to school, university, [...] guide them, give them proper guidance; make a committee - form a committee for their counseling and guidance so that the Jamā'at's students can have a better opportunity to select their subjects, [so that] they are properly guided. This is the work of the Ta'lim [department]."

Addressing the Amir, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) said, "Now you can see to it that, if needed, and just to efficiently carry out your work, you should appoint different people for different posts. And if the Jamā'at has elected the same person for a different post, then you can ask the Centre to get permission from me.

Hussein, Secretary of reported on Finance, various budgetary matters. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V asked if he was satisfied with the Chanda of the members and what was being done to make it up to the mark. Safir Hussein replied that over the last few years, they had improved and were slowly moving up.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) explained, "All the members, and especially those who have lucrative businesses, those who are well off, and those who are affluent people, should pay their Chanda according to the prescribed rate. And they should know the importance of Chanda, [...] they should pay Chanda to win the love of Allah the Almighty. That should be the main purpose of paying the Chanda.

Farhan Ogir said he was a member of the Amila and Finance Committee, and reported that he was dealing with special projects of the Jamā'at. Speaking to Secretary Waqf-e-Nau, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) asked him if he was a Waqf-e-Nau and also asked about his profession. The secretary replied in the affirmative and said he was an optometrist.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V went on to explain, "So, after having attained the age of 15 and above, children themselves should renew their bond; that they will continue [their waqf] or not."

In light of his Ja'idad duties, Riyad Din reported that they have seven mosques and four mission houses.

Abdul Noor, a missionary at Valencia and serving as the National

Secretary for Tabligh, said he was originally from Haiti. He reported that in the last three years, there have been 5-7 new converts in his region alone. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) explained, "Ask all your Secretaries of Tabligh that they should work hard, make a proper Tabligh plan, and get more Bai'ats." Upon this. Abdul Noor said, In-Sha-Allah. Hearing this, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V smiled and said, "Now, In-Sha-Allah should be Masha-Allah [...] Allah helps those who work hard."

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) asked how many Ahmadis were in the Tobago region, to which Bashir Qwow reported that there were no Ahmadis there before and added that since they had arrived, they had converted 8 people.

"No Ahmadi in Tobago? What has Amir Sahib been doing in the last 40 years, there?" Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) then addressed Amir Sahib and asked how long he had been there, to which Amir Sahib replied that he had been there for 35 years. "And during these 35 years, you couldn't have even a single Bai'at." Amir Sahib reported that they had some Bai'ats; however, they migrated to other countries.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V then addressed Amir Sahib in Urdu and firmly admonished him to work diligently to achieve a transformative impact in Trinidad and Tobago.

Speaking with Naveed Ishaq, a Ghanaian missionary serving in Tobago, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper) said, "Only 65,000 people are living in Tobago, so you should try to convert the whole habitation to Ahmadiyyat [...] There are three missionaries there; you should bring about a revolution there." Abdul Karim Qudsi was a renowned poet in the Community. His marriage was announced by the Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih III (may Allah shower His mercy on him). He is survived by four children. 
The National President, S Nizam Khan, also delivered an address in Sinhala on the true concept of jihad.

Announcement of Ramadan and Eids 2024

The National Calendar was presented at the National Amila Meeting on December 9, 2023. It is being shared with all Jamā'ats immediately.

Members are asking about the dates of the start of Ramadan and Eid days. Respected Amir has appointed a Moonsighting Committee of the U.S.A. Jamā'at that is responsible for announcing the start of Ramadan and Eid days.

Professor Hameed Naseem, Chair of the Committee, wrote:

After considering the crescent moon visibility maps, which have been developed based on the data provided by Her Majesty's Nautical Almanac Office (U.K.) and using the criterion of visibility with the naked eye (without the use of any optical aid), the Moonsighting Committee has recommended the following for the Calendar Year 2024:

1. Start of Ramadhan:

- 1.1. The first day of Ramadan in the continental U.S. and the state of Alaska will be Tuesday, March 12, 2024,
- 1.2. The first day of Ramadan in Puerto Rico will also be on Tuesday, March 12, 2024. Whereas
- 1.3. The first day of Ramadan in Hawaii will be Monday, March 11, 2024.

2. Eid ul Fitr:


Eid ul Fitr in the continental U.S. and the states of Alaska and Hawaii will be on Wednesday, April 10, 2024. (We will have 29 days of Ramadan for the continental U.S. and the state of Alaska, whereas in Hawaii, Ramadan this year will be 30 days).

In Puerto Rico, Eid ul Fitr will be on Wednesday, April 10, 2024.

3. Eid ul Adha

- 3.1. Eid ul Adha will be on Monday, June 17, 2024, in the continental U.S.
- 3.2. Eid ul Adha will be on Monday, June 17, 2024, in the states of Alaska and Hawaii

- Al-Furqan: From Jan 2022 Dec 2022, in each of the three data collection periods, on average 743 students from Lajna Imā'illāh, Nāsirat-ul-Ahmadiyya, Atfāl-ul Ahmadiyya, and a few members of Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya attended Holy Qur'an courses in Recitation, Translation, Commentary, and Memorization. The total number of students for the year may have been well above this average. A conservative estimate is being provided to avoid duplication of the same students taking courses the entire year. Data for Jan 2023 Mar 2023 will be collected later In-Sha-Allah as Female faculty is given time off during Ramadan.
- Male faculty taught a total of 241 students. There are 25 Certified Male Teachers in the faculty of which 7 new

- teachers were certified in this reporting period.
- Ameen Ceremony at Jalsa Salana West Coast: Ameen ceremony was held during Jalsa West Coast on Sat,
 Dec 24, 2022. TaQWA booth was set up at the Jalsa where many Jamā'at members visited. Flyers on AlFurqan and Waqf-e-Ardi were distributed on the Lajna side. Atfāl and Nāsirat who visited the booth were
 given chocolates.
- National Qur'an Conference 2022: The National Virtual Qur'an Conference was held on October 30th, 2022, via Zoom. Overall attendance was 550+ members. Parallel to the main Conference, an engaging program for children was also held with interactive presentations. Over 220 kids attended. The Kahoot quiz was a favorite and was enjoyed by over 80 participants. In addition, 50+ kids volunteered to recite Ta'awwudh and Tasmia for all.
- Annual Hifz-ul-Qur'an Camp 2022: The National Hifz Camp was successfully held for 10 days for Nāsirat and Atfāl in July. 93 Atfāl and Nāsirat registered for the Camp. 82 students were accepted. 65 students were able to attend till the end. 72+ Huffaz, Certified Teachers, Assistants, Admins, and Administrators volunteered during the camp.
- Regional Qur'an Conferences: Regional Ta'līm-ul-Qur'an Classes were held during the year. The theme of the program was to inform Jamā'at members about the department's goals and inculcate the love of the Holy Qur'an via inspirational speeches, providing available resources and encouraging members to step forward to learn and become Holy Qur'an teachers and teach our young generation. Similarly, members were encouraged to participate in Waqf-e-Ardi. 4 Regional conferences were held (2 virtual and 2 Onsite).
- Hifz Program: Out of 3 students 2 have memorized 8 parts. One left because she couldn't meet the criteria. In October 2022, during the USA visit, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) granted permission for Hifz Madrasah (school). A working team was set up and a couple of meetings took place.

- Quite a few initiatives were completed during the reporting period such as the comprehensive reconciliation of records in the national database, the launch of Waqf-e-Nau Hub, the first-ever Career Expo with Ahmadi professionals, the redesigning of Online classes, Jami'a's open house, the launch of Voice of Waqf-e-Nau monthly newsletter, Waqf-e-Nau website refresh, etc.
- High-Level Achievements: Special Waqf-e-Nau Classes with Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper), Special classes with Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V were held in Dallas, TX & Bait-ur-Rahman, MD on October 5, 2012, and October 12, 2022 respectively. 90 Wāqifāt-e-Nau and 99 Wāqifān-e-Nau (boys) attended the Dallas class while 201 Wāqifāt & 209 Wāqifān-e-Nau (boys) attended the Bait-ur-Rahman Class.
- Monthly Meetings & Telegram Group: Local Secretaries were added to a Telegram Group for almost daily communication from/to the National Team and local/Regional Secretaries. This is in addition to a monthly call with Local and Regional Secretaries on the third Thursday of each month.
- West Coast Jalsa Salana: Interactive programs were held at the West Coast Jalsa Salana both at the Lajna

side and the Men's side including a Q&A with missionaries.

- 2023 Career Expo: First-ever Career Expo was held fully hybridized (available in-person and virtually) and covered 23 distinct careers by 45 field experts in 34 different sessions.
- Jami'a Inspiration Camp & Virtual Open House: In collaboration with MKA USA, the Waqf-e-Nau Department held a 3.5-hour "Jami'a Inspiration Camp & Virtual Open House" event on Zoom. This event was attended by 260 members of USA Jamā'at.
- Fax to Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) Service: A new "Fax to Khalifatul-Masih" portal is created allowing Wāqifīn-e-Nau and Parents to send a Fax to Khalifatul-Masih. This also allows a template-driven fax for parents wanting to dedicate an unborn child. This portal is available on the waqfenau.us website.
- Waqf-e-Ardi: In one of the Mulaqat, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) instructed Secretary Waqf-e-Nau USA to promote Waqf-e-Ardi amongst Wāqifīn-e-Nau. In this regard, the Waqf-e-Nau department is preparing a portal where Waqf-e-Ardi Internships hosted by various Jamā'at departments and organizations. 6 Khuddam (3 Wāqifīn-e-Nau) did a Waqf-e-Ardi with MTA USA in Spring, 2023

Khilafat in 2023

Friday sermons and addresses on important occasions of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah support him with His mighty help) are an invaluable treasure of advice and guidance for the Ahmadiyya Community worldwide. A few of them in the year 2023 are mentioned below.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V at the end of Friday's Sermon of 30 December 2022, prayed that Allah the Almighty bestow His blessings with the coming of the **new year 2023**. May this new year be blessed for the Community. May all plots and ploys of the enemy be foiled. May Ahmadis worldwide fulfill the purpose of their lives more than ever before. He urged prayers for the world; may Allah save the world from war. The world's conditions continue to deteriorate and stand on the precipice of destruction. He also prayed for all those Ahmadis who are enduring injustices; may Allah the Almighty keep all members of the Community safe from injustice and cruelty in the new year.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V held virtual meetings of the National Amila of different countries, educational **online classes** with auxiliaries (Ansarullah, Khuddām-ul-Ahmadiyya, and Lajna Imā'illāh) and Waqf-e-Nau (Boys and Girls) of many countries during the year 2023.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih announced that by the Grace of Allah, members of the Jama'at were able to make a total sacrifice of £9.6 million in Chanda **Waqf Jadid in 2022**, which is an increase of £500,000 from the previous year.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V announced the start of the ninetieth year of **Tahrik Jadid**. The **number of mosques** in 220 countries of the world is more than 9,300. The number of **mission houses** is more than 3,400. There are dozens of mosques and mission houses currently under construction. The number of missionaries and *Mu'allimeen* (teachers) in the world is close to 5,000 and is increasing. The **Holy Qur'an** has been translated into 77 languages. Literature in various languages continues to be published and a lot of other work is also being done through *Tahrik Jadid* along with other schemes. In the previous year, the worldwide Ahmadiyya Muslim Community offered a sacrifice of 17.20 million pounds, an increase of over £700,000 compared to last year. 
Institute of Electric and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) selects Dr. Hamid Rahim

Love is one of the strongest emotions people can experience. The Taj Mahal, the story of Romeo Juliet, Laila, and Majnoon – all were created to give shape to the fire of love that burns within us.

Islam is a religion that is built upon human nature and has directed us in the proper use of all of our faculties and emotions, including love. Primarily, Islam is a religion of love. That may surprise some people, as it is usually Christianity that emphasizes its association with love. But it is Islam that teaches us to love both Allah and our fellow man and to practically show that love by fulfilling the rights of both, to an extent that is not found in other religions.

Expanding on this principle, the Holy Qur'an has induced obedience and sincere love to the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). The Holy Qur'an states:

قُلُ إِنْ كَانَ ابَآؤُكُمْ وَاَبْنَآؤُكُمْ وَاِخْوَانُكُمْ وَازُوَاجُكُمْ وَاخْوَانُكُمْ وَامْوَالُ اِقْتَرَفْتُمُوْهَا وَتَجَارَةٌ تَخْشَوُنَ كَسَادَهَا وَمَسْكِنُ تَرْضَوْنَهَآ اَحَبَّ الْنَيْكُمُ مِّنَ اللهِ وَرَسُولِه وَجِهَادٍ فِيُ سَبِيْلِهٖ فَتَرَبَّصُوا حَتَّى يَأْتِيَ اللهُ بِاَمْرِهِ وَاللهُ لَا يَهْمِيهِ فَتَرَبَّصُوا حَتَّى يَأْتِيَ اللهُ بِاَمْرِهِ وَاللهُ لَا يَهْدِى الْقَوْمَ الْفُسِقِيْنَ

Say, if your fathers, and your

sons, and your brethren, and your wives, and your kinsfolk, and the wealth you have acquired, and the trade whose dullness you fear, and the dwellings which you love are dearer to you than Allah and His Messenger and strive in His cause, then wait until Allah comes with His judgment; and Allah guides not the disobedient people. [9:24]

There a hadith throws further light upon this verse:

Once, a companion approached the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) and stated, "O Messenger of Allah, I love you." The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) replied, "How much do you love me?" the Companion replied, "As much as I love my children." The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) replied, "Then you are not a believer. More love than this is required for faith." companion stated, Messenger of Allah! I love you as much as I love myself." The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) remarked, "Even now you cannot be a believer. Because more love than this is required for faith." The companion then stated, "O Messenger of Allah! I

love you more than my life, my wealth my wife, and my children!" The Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) finally stated, "Now you are a believer." (Anwar-ul-Uloom, vol. 23, p. 157)

This level of love was practically demonstrated by the companions of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). They were abused and ridiculed, driven out of their homes, and ostracized by friends and families for their faith. Yet never did they prefer any worldly connection to the spiritual connection of love and fidelity that they had with their holy master peace Muhammad (may blessings of Allah be on him).

A small example of this love is found in the life of Hazrat Abu Bakr (may Allah be pleased with him). He left his home and migrated to Medina from Mecca with the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). He stayed with him through every trial from the first day of his prophethood to the last. When news arrived of the death of his beloved companion, Hazrat Abu Bakr was outside of Medina. He went straight to the mosque without speaking to anybody. When he reached his body, he raised the sheet

covering his blessed face, kissed him on the forehead, and said, "My father and my mother be sacrificed for you, O Allah's Prophet! Allah will not combine two deaths on you. You have died the death which was written for you." (Sahih Bukhari, Book of Funerals)

The depth of their devotion moves us even today, 1400 years after their bodies have been laid to rest. But it is the practice of Allah that he leaves no era of Islam without a living example to follow. And we are blessed that we are in an age that has seen the advent of the greatest reformer that was to appear in Islam, the Promised Reformer and Mahdi, Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani (peace be on him). He has shown us what it truly means to love the Holy Prophet. God Himself bore witness to the love he harbored for the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). He states:

On one occasion I received a revelation which indicated that there was a difference among the higher angels. The indication was that the will of God was prepared to bring about a renaissance of Islam, but the angels had not yet been informed of the identity of the rejuvenator. Hence that was being debated. At the same time, I saw in a dream that a search was being made for one who should revive the faith. A person appeared before me and pointing to me said:

That is [Arabic] This is the man who loves the Messenger (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) of Allah.

His meaning was that the principal condition of this assignment was the love of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) and that I fulfilled that condition.

In many of his writings, he made it abundantly clear that he was ever ready to sacrifice his every possession to defend the honor and teachings of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). He wrote in one place:

Is it not true that in a short while in India alone a hundred thousand people have become Christians, more than sixty million books have been published in opposition to Islam, people belonging to high families have lost their religion, and those who used to describe themselves as the descendants of the Holy Prophet [peace and blessings of Allah be on him] have put on the garment of Christianity and have his enemies. become and numberless books full of vile abuse of the Holy Prophet [peace and blessings of Allah be on him] have been published? My heart cries out with tears that if these people had murdered my children before my eyes, and had cut to pieces my sincere friends, and had killed me great humiliation, and possessed themselves of all my property, I would not have been so pained and my heart would not have been so hurt as it has been pained and hurt by the insults offered to the Holy Prophet [peace and blessings of Allah be on him].

So great was his love for his Holy master that prose was not enough to convey the depth of his emotion. The Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) thus wrote poem after poem, in Arabic, Urdu and Persian conveying the love that he had for Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). He wrote in one place:

After Allah, I am " intoxicated with the love of Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him)

If this is disbelief, then by Allah, I am a severe disbeliever" (Ruhani Khazā'in, vol.20, Lecture Sialkot, p. 248)

In an Arabic couplet, he expressed his love in the following manner:

"My heart is completely submersed in the love of the land that Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) tread upon.

Alas! I wish that my birth had been in your land!"

(Ruhani Khazā'in, vol. 7, Karamat ul Sadiqueen, p. 93)

In Urdu, he wrote in one place:

"By your exalted personage my beloved Ahmad

It is for your sake that we have taken up this entire burden."

(Ruhani Khazā'in, vol. 5, Ā'īna Kamālāt e Islam, p. 225)

The love he harbored for the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) was not limited to his pen – the people around him were eyewitnesses to how his activities and actions shone with the love of his Holy Master (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him).

Dr. Mir Muhammad Ismael narrates that when the Promised Messiah would mention the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) in his addresses or a gathering, he would usually do so in these loving words, that "Our Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) said such and such." In the same way, in writing he would not just refer to the Holy

Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) by merely saying "He," but he would write the full salutation after it as well, which was "Peace and Blessings of Allah be Upon Him"

(Seerat-ul-Mahdi, Narration #547)

Hazrat Sheikh Yaqoob Ali Irfani (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated that once when I went to England in 1925, I desired to visit Pastor Dr. White Brakhit because he had remained a missionary in Batala and had met the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) many times. During our conversation, he stated:

"I have observed one thing in Mirza Sahib which I disliked. That was whenever an objection was raised on Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) he would become upset, and his face would show signs of displeasure."

Sheikh Yaqoob Ali Irfani replied:

"Pastor, that both aspects which you dislike are liked by me." (Hayate-Ahmad, vol. 1, Part 3, p. 384)

Once, the cousin of his wife Mirza Ghulam Haider uttered a word against the high station of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Upon this he became so upset that despite all the emotions of love and respect he had for her and his desire for reconciliation between people, he left the food he was eating at their table and never again returned there for a meal. (Seerat Masih Mauʻūd, vol. 2, p. 270)

In short, whoever came into contact with the Promised Messiah, whether friend, family, or foe, bore witness to the love he held for the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). And the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) was not satisfied that only he harbors a love for the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) – he had made it his mission to inculcate the love of his Holy Master in all those who claimed to follow him. He made it a requirement for anyone who wished to follow him that they daily pray for blessings on his Holy Master. He wrote as the third condition of pledging allegiance with him:

He/she shall regularly offer the five daily Prayers by the commandments of God and the Holy Prophet Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) and shall try his/ her best to be regular in offering the Tahajjud and invoking Durūd on the Holy Prophet Muhammad (may peace and

blessings of Allah be on him). He/she shall make it his/her daily routine to ask forgiveness for his/her sins, to remember the bounties of God and to praise and glorify Him. (Conditions of Bai'at and Responsibilities of an Ahmadi, p. 51)

Our beloved Imam, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be his Helper) elaborated on this aspect in the following words:

"It is incumbent upon every Muslim to invoke salutations and blessings (Darūd) on the Holv **Prophet** (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) because without it one cannot fulfill the requisite of love for him. In addition, prayer that is without Darūd does not gain acceptance. The real motive for invoking Darūd should be the love of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be on him)." (Friday Sermon, February 1, 2013)

May Allah enable us all to follow the example of the Promised Messiah (may peace be on him) and harbor greater love for the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Amen!


Denmark's parliament adopts legislation to prohibit the desecration of religious writings

AP News agency reported on 7 December 2023 that Denmark's parliament adopted legislation in its parliament to prohibit desecration of any holy manuscript. It was done after a recent burning of the Holy Qur'ān in public by anti-Islam activists. The law was passed in the parliament in a 94-77 vote. The new law declared it a crime to desecrate holy scriptures. Those violating the law shall be jailed for up to two years with a fine.

In 2006, Denmark was subjected to widespread anger by Muslims after a Danish newspaper published twelve caricatures of the Holy Prophet Muhammad, peace and blessings of Allah be on him.

French authorities arrest a guru for malpractice

The Dawn published in Pakistan reported that French authorities arrested a Gregorian Bivolaru, a guru, and forty-one people during a raid on the yoga sect. Several women of different nationalities had been victims of the sect and its leader. The women were motivated to have sexual relations with the guru and involved in pornographic practices in France and abroad. Introductory remarks

Instinct is a blessing bestowed upon every human being, animal, and aquatic creature by God, the Almighty. All the creatures of God are subordinate to this noble and worthy blessing. It is the inherent feeling of living beings. Because of this, those having life, do routine day-to-day work unknowingly even though they did not see what their ancestors had been doing. So, it is a natural desire or tendency to do things in a guided fashion. Living know things instinct without learning it. Examples of this can be witnessed and tested at all times like indelible impressions in the factory of nature. The ingredients of instinct have been engraved in the memory of all living things. Research has proven that this memory chip is present in their DNA (Deoxyribonucleic Acid).

What is DNA? It is an inherited substance that is the blueprint of every living organism. It can be called a tiny but very powerful piece of human building bloc. Just like the solar system and galaxies that are moving under a fixed program, the same way the trait of instinct is annihilating and pulverizing under the system devised in all living

organisms. It doesn't exhibit many changes from generation generation. Whoever has come into this world, whether he lives in any part of the world, whether he is poor or rich, young, or old, sick, or healthy, there is absolutely no difference in the modes of instinct. The trait of instinct applies equally to everyone. The color of your skin or where vou were born does not matter. Everyone in the present world has an inherent set of instinctive behaviors that differs from one species to the other.

Instinct can be defined as: "The ability of all the living beings to think, feel, and behave, which has never been learned or understood from anywhere else. It is a great hereditary method of performing desires and other essentials bestowed upon by nature. It does not require all living beings to think, understand, or learn to accomplish day-to-day usage. Instinct in living beings is affected by the surrounding environment in some way. To perform a certain work, living beings exhibit some special ways for their movements, which are special only to them and other living organisms do not have that method or habit. Instinct is a natural alarm system that tells weak animals to safeguard

themselves and not to be preyed on by powerful animals, and they protect themselves in the blink of an eye by hiding somewhere, especially when they are engaged in fighting or having sex. Man's intellect is unable to understand nature's amazing miracles of instinct. It is a special gift from God.

God says in Surah Luqman: وَإِذَا غَشِيَهُمْ مَّوْجٌ كَالظُّلَلِ دَعَوُا اللهَ مُخْلِصِيْنَ لَهُ الدِّيْنَ ۚ فَلَمَّا نَجُّهُمْ إِلَى الْبَرِّ فَمِنْهُمْ مُّقْتَصِدٌ وَمَا يَجْحَدُبِاٰ يٰتِنَاۤ اِلْا كُلُّ خَتَّارٍ كَفُوْرٍ

"And when waves engulf them like so many coverings, they call upon Allah, being sincere to Him in faith; but when He brings them safe to land, then some of them take the right course. And none denies Our Signs save every perfidious and ungrateful person." (31[Luqman]: 33)

Explanation of the verse by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV, may Allah shower His mercy on him:

This verse refers to an essential aspect of human psychology that when they are engulfed in a seastorm, whether they are atheists or polytheists, they call upon none else

but Allah. And once Allah has rescued them, they revert to their earlier state of mind. The *Muqtasideen*, i.e., the moderate, are exempt from such people mentioned here who are engulfed in such storms. They do not forget Allah even after they have reached the land. [Urdu translation of the Holy Qur'ān by Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīḥ IV, p. 718 (footnote)]

This proves that God has instilled his love and the habit of calling Him in trouble in the human instinct. Whether a person believes it or not, God dwells in the hearts of His creatures, when they call upon Him, He listens and overcomes their difficulties and establishes His sovereignty.

The divine system of instinct is embodied in man's body parts. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (may Allah shower His mercy on him) writes in the summary of Surah Al-Waqi'ah:

For instance, the eye, ear, nose, mouth, throat, vocal cord, etc. were directed in so detail as to up to what size an organ will grow; and when that growth will stop. Take teeth for example. Deciduous teeth appear after a certain period and fall after a certain period. And the children who fail to look after the health of their teeth in childhood are saved from the evil effects of that. Then, in adult teeth, a person is responsible for looking after them. Why do they stop developing after a certain size? What stops them from developing any further? There is a computerized program in human DNA that is followed by them according to the decree of Allah Almighty. Scientists say that teeth grow at almost the same speed as they wear out. If they had continued developing and there was no program of stopping them in that case human lower teeth, piercing the brain, would have grown much further. And the upper teeth could have rendered the chest useless by piercing lower jaws. Allah says, did you produce these genetic

characteristics yourself? Obviously, the reply is negative. Similarly, man believes that it is he who sown the seeds in the soil. But the mechanism of their germination and development into trees, vegetables, and fruits is a very complicated system, which cannot develop on its own. (Urdu translation by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (may Allah shower His mercy on him), pp. 983-984)

In Surah Bani Israel verse 14, Allah says:

And every man's works have We fastened to his neck, and on the Day of Resurrection, We shall bring out for him a book which he will find wide open. (Here the word ظائر (Ta'ir) does not stand for a bird, in that as if a bird is fastened to every man's neck. Rather it refers to the list of his works, which is not attached in the apparent form; but will be revealed on the Day of Resurrection. It is the same as it is said in Urdu "گریبان میں منہ ڈال کر دیکھو کہ تم کیسے ہو" i.e., to search one's own heart). [Urdu translation of the Holy Qur'an by Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh IV, p. 465 (footnote)]

That is, God has placed a memory chip in DNA with the human body, which records and preserves all his movements, and good and evil deeds. This shows that the law of instinct is written on it. The recording system on it has also been working since time immemorial, which will be revealed in the form of an open book on the Day of Resurrection, which no one shall be able to deny. There is no room for any addition or deficiency in God's judicial system. This system is the same for everyone.

The subject of instinct becomes clearer in Surah Ha Mim As-Sajdah, verses 21-24:

Translation: Till, when they reach it, their ears and their eyes and

their skins will bear witness against them as to what they had been doing. And they will say to their skins: "Why bear ye witness against us?" They will say: "Allah has made us to speak as He has made everything else to speak. And He it is Who created you the first time, and unto Him have you been brought back. And you did not fear while committing sins that your ears and your eyes and your skins would bear witness against you, nay, you thought that even Allah did not know much of what you used to do. And that thought of yours, which you entertained concerning your Lord, has ruined you. So now you have become of those who are lost."

From these Qur'anic verses, it can be derived without any argument that the DNA of human components records his actions all the time and will reveal everything on the Day of Resurrection. Instinct is also subject to God's creative system. Everything a person does in this world is recorded in his memory chip and is an integral part of DNA.

A few observations and events of instinct

Man / Woman:

Man has greatly benefited from instinct and its characteristics and will continue to do so. Naturally, he is born with the good and bad habits of his ancestors. God has made him better than all living beings and endowed him with infinite wisdom and understanding. It is up to him how he benefits from these qualities and how he restrains himself from evils. Man's instinct prevents him from saying things he should have not said. It also keeps him at a distance that is unsuitable for him. Tickling some parts of the body induces involuntary twitching and smile or laughter.

There are a few separate examples of male and female instincts.

In men, it has been observed that they usually feel shivering or hysterical condition inside the spinal cord while urinating, whereas in women it is not or very rare. A human child is a born swimmer, if he is thrown into deep water, then he starts paddling and kicking instantaneously. At the age of four months, if the cheek of a child is tickled, he turns his face toward the same side.

For example, when a mother sees her newborn child, her maternal instinct arouses and she naturally knows in advance that her child is going to have something wrong. It is also called intuition or sixth sense. This is also an aspect of instinct. The human baby's milk from the mother's breasts is a great example of instinct. Some mothers do not feel milk in their breasts but as the child cries for milk, it has often been observed that they start feeling milk in their breasts. Instinct helps the baby to drink breast milk. It has been observed that when mothers beat their toddlers', they cry and cling to their mothers. It is in their instinct that their benefactor is none other than their mothers.

Animals:

If animals are studied, there are many observations of instinct. All cats have the inbuilt instinct of hunting. Take the dog. It is loyal to the owner and even risks its life for him or her. It is in his instinct that he trembles with a jerk to dry the water from its wet fur. It digs the pit and urinates with one leg raised. Its expertise is employed to keep the herd of sheep and goats together. To improve this skill, dogs are specially trained and large herds are collected from large fields with the help of a dog. Dogs that keep sheep or cattle in a group are due to their herding instinct.

Meerkat Manor usually stands on his hind legs and keeps an eye on the enemies around him. They report to each other in times of difficulty and quickly hide. These are all miracles of instinct.

Birds:

The world might have been incomplete without birds of different varieties and colors. The presence of

birds gives a sense of human life. It feels great for birds to have a special kind of chirping, singing, and around with fluttering wings spreading. The song pattern of many birds is inherited. These characteristics of birds are subject to inbuilt instinct. It can be observed that birds keep improving their song quality by listening to contemporary adult birds. The chirping of birds makes the atmosphere pleasant. The lyrics of their songs show a desire to call each other and have sex. Nature has put all this in their instincts and no one teaches them about it. Their nesting style is different from each other.




Hanging nest of typical birds

It is written in their genes about how they will make the nest and what kind of weeds and trunks they will take help in making it. Birds may never have seen their elders making nests. Many birds nest in trees and some in hollow spaces in a hillside. Some of them have nests hanging from trees to avoid tree-climbing animals.

Crows do not make nests. They can be seen in large numbers towards the tree trunks in the evening.

When the female duck sets out with her little chicks in search of food, chicks follow her in a row. Similarly, cranes and many birds also fly in a certain order.

Many birds migrate to other places due to the paucity of food and water before the setting of hard weather conditions.

The Alpine Swift shuttles between Africa and Europe for more than six months without taking any rest. This bird falls asleep during the flight and survives by eating insects flying in the wind. Such a long expedition in a particular season is built into its instinct. It never happened that it did not go on a long journey and frozen to death in its home. The desire to live forces birds to go through difficult phases. No one teaches all this except nature.

Insects:

Insects living in this land of God are also part of the system of instinct. Insects also receive the blessings of God abundantly.

The bee is a wonderful insect. Among Muslims, it has a special significance as the Holy Quran denotes it as a cure for mankind. The Holy Qur'ān states in Surah al-Nahl, verses 69 and 70:

"And thy Lord has inspired the bee, saying, "Make thou houses in the hills and the trees and in the trellises which they build. Then eat of every kind of fruit, and follow the ways of thy Lord that have been made easy for thee." There comes forth from their bellies a drink of varying hues. Therein is a cure for men. Surely, that is a Sign for a people who reflect."

The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) loved honey and milk. Honey has many benefits. The bee hive is very beautiful. It can be called a masterpiece of the art of engineering. A honey storage cell is hexagonal. Each side of this cell is exactly equal to each other and there is no deviation of even a millimeter. When the bees put honey in the hive, they later fill it with wax to keep the honey safe for a long time. They go dancing toward food to connect. No one gives them these instructions except Allah, who has inscribed all their works in their instincts.

The spider web is the weakest house it builds to trap prey, but it is so strong that even strong winds cannot break it. In the same way, the silver spider keeps collecting seeds for rainy days. The spider's intelligence is unexplainable. Its inbuilt instinct is bestowed on it by none other than God, the Almighty.

Some types of butterflies undertake a long migration to wintering grounds they have never seen before.

A certain ant named Atta Sexdens which inhibits in Brazil makes a nest in the soil. It stores the nest with leaves in such a way that the nest looks like an underground garden. It plants small fungi which later grow and become its food supply for its young ones and itself. The queen ant undertakes the duty of making a new nest. It takes into its mouth a small quantity of fungus which shall be needed to start the new nest. It manures the fungi with its excrement. Aquatic creatures:

Many fish are very intelligent and clever. Salmon is one such fish that floats in the opposite direction of the flow of water. It travels thousands of miles from one place to another. It is written in their genes. The eggs are laid only in clean waters and the babies leave for migration to their mothers after hatching from the eggs. This period ranges from 6 months to 7 years. During this period, she lives her life of puberty and then turns to clean waters to lay eggs again. This continues. Some salmon fish travel up to 2,500 miles one-way. It has never happened that they do not migrate so far and return to the clean waters for breeding.

The instinctive behavior of baby leatherback sea turtles is amazing. When the sea turtle is born on the beach, its weak legs automatically turn towards the sea without thinking and it reaches the water and starts swimming. No one has taught them this act, but it is in their instinct to do so, from which they cannot turn away. If he goes against his instincts, he will fall prey to birds flying over the sea.

Hibernation

In the harsh winter season, many animals sleep for a long time. During this time, they eat nothing or drink very little. In this period, their heart rate decreases to 2-3 beats per minute. They choose not to wake from their sleep the whole winter. The number of animals, birds, or insects that do this is not high, but surprisingly, they survive during this period and later live normally. It would be appropriate to call it a miracle of instinct.

America's black, Asia's black and brown, and polar bears sleep in one place. The female bear gives birth to children during this time. This period can usually be up to 100 days. At this time, their heart rate decreases from 40,50 to 8 per minute.

Similarly, an Alpine Marmot is an animal that hibernates for up to 8 months and breathes only 2 or 3 breaths in a minute and its heart movement is reduced from 120 to only 3 to 4. They spend four months when they are awake, having babies. Similarly, certain types of turtles also hibernate from 77 days to 154 days.

The Common Poorwill bird sleeps for about 5 months in bad weather.



In the event of a drop in temperature, the queen bee hides in the soil or leaves and hibernates, but the poor working and other male bees do not do so and die due to cold weather. Their hibernation period ranges from 6 to 8 months. The queen bee then resumes her life. Man can only observe the wonders of nature and have no option but to admire God, the Almighty.



Big brown Bats

In the wild, big brown bats spend 64-66 days in hibernation.

They do not have to eat but they do wake up to drink. Their heart rate drops from 1000 beats per minute to only 25 and some bats only take a breath every two hours. (Mark Carwardine, Animal Records, New York: Sterling Publishing Co., 2008, pp. 29-30)



Fat-tailed Dwarf Lemurs of Madagascar

Fat-tailed Dwarf Lemurs of Madagascar pick a tree and hibernate there for about seven months in cold spells of weather until the rains return in November. During hibernation, they live off the fat in their tail, losing close to 50% of their body weight. (Terry A. Vaughan et al, Mammalogy, Jones and Bartlett Learning 2011, p. 172)

Hedgehogs are some of the deepest hibernators around. Some can sleep through the whole winter! Their body temperature drops and they breathe so little that it can hardly be seen. They have special cells that release heat 20 times faster than white cells. If temperatures drop too low, their heartbeat picks up to produce more heat, which wakes them up briefly before they fall asleep again. (Maurice Burton, Robert Burton. The International Wildlife Encyclopedia. Marshall Cavendish, 1970: Page 1173)

Snail

Snails have a built-in bed for their hibernation. They go into their shell and close up the hole with a skin made of chalk and slime that keeps the moisture in. During this time, they use almost no energy and don't have to eat anything at all. In some areas where there is little rain, snails can hibernate for years! (Mark Fox. Discovering night creatures. Curriculum Press, 2002: Page 48 Andrew Hipp. The life cycle of a

Conclusion

How is instinct embedded in DNA and how are habits passed down from generation generation? Genetic Memory can explain this fact to some extent, through which living beings show instinct. We have not vet been able to understand the true reality of instinct. Someone has said, "A person should learn to trust his instincts and accept what the heart says because the heart never leaves you alone."

The Conference opened with the recitation of a portion from the Holy Ouran by Lt. Intisar Ahmad Abbasi who also presented the English version of the verses. This was followed by an inaugural short speech by Seyyed Mahmud Ahmad Nasir who exhorted the members against despair. He encouraged the audience by an analogy that the First Annual Gathering held by the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) in 1891 was attended by 75 persons, but last year almost 190,000 persons participated in the Annual Gathering of the Jamā'at at Rabwah, Pakistan. In the early afternoon, auxiliaries held their separate meetings.


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



Research by Dr. Mahmud Ahmad Nagi

On April 16, 1944, the fourth and final public meeting was held in Delhi, the capital of India, to announce the "Living Sign" Hazrat Muslih Mau'ūd, may Allah be pleased with him" and to complete the argument on the people of India. The venue of the meeting was the Queen's Garden adjacent to the Harding Library. About thousand Ahmadis from Punjab, UP, suburbs of Delhi, and Hyderabad attended Deccan the sacred congregation. (Daily Al-Fazl Rabwah, 20 April 1944, p. 6)

With the announcement of this meeting, a series of provocative speeches started in Delhi. The posters were also distributed in the city. People were provoked and all possible measures were taken to stop the meeting. The arrangements were made for a separate meeting place for the ladies. At the beginning of the meeting, the recitation of the Holy Quran had just begun when the miscreants started shouting and creating a commotion. They started to disrupt the meeting by resorting to abuses. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II (may Allah be pleased with him) asked the members of Jama'at to sit down. Those who are outside the venue of the meeting should also

come in. He also instructed Ahmadis not to respond to anyone. After this, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II began his address. The mob started moving towards the stage with the intention of attacking, which was blocked by appropriate measures. The crowd continued to pelt stones at the venue from outside. Many people inched towards the sitting place reserved for ladies only. A group of young Ahmadi youths stood outside the ladies' place for shielding. Stones started hurling towards the women's meeting place and the whole meeting place was surrounded from all sides. There was a danger that they might harm the women. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih asked one hundred Khuddam to go out to safeguard the women and instructed the rest to keep sitting. My father Mian Muhammad Yahya, who had gone to Delhi from Lahore to participate in the meeting, was among Khuddām entrusted with the security duty. In his address, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II invited non-Ahmadi friends to come to Qadian and tell us their aims and objectives within the framework of decency. We will make all their arrangements and also bear the expenses. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih challenged them to come together and confront me with any part of the Qur'an after taking all possible from all the written commentaries. In-Sha-Allah victory will be ours. He further added:

"I announce after receiving a revelation from God that the prophecy mentioned by Hazrat Masih Mauʻūd, peace be on him, in the poster of 20 February 1886, has been fulfilled. God has informed me through a vision that I am the recipient of the prophecy of Muslih Mauʻūd. And the whole world one day shall recite the Kalima of the Holy Prophet (may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), through me and my followers." (Daily Al-Fazl Rabwah, 23 April 1944, p. 2)

In the meantime, the miscreants announced in the city that the Ahmadis had attacked, on which about 7,000 people got ready for further attack. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih ordered the evacuation of the women's place of meeting. Non-Ahmadi women were evacuated first. Some women sustained severe head injuries due to stone pelting by the mob resulting in fractures of head bone in three places. About 40 Ahmadis were injured. To take the women to safer places, the hundred Khuddam continued to perform duty and fought the miscreants. My father

used to say that the crowd had fled like sheep and goats. The Ahmadi Khuddām were running after them and drove the crowd away from the vicinity of the meeting. On that day, Ahmadi Khuddām thrashed them so much that they would remember it for the rest of their lives.

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II said while delivering the Friday Sermon on 21 April 1944:

Allah, the Almighty provided us with comfort and progress in faith.

The Promised Messiah (peace be on him) said, "I saw in my dream I had gone to Delhi and had returned safe." Then the revelation flowed from my tongue:

(Translation: All praise belongs to Allah, who has brought me safe)

After this revelation, the Promised Messiah (peace be on him) did not go to Delhi. His last journey to Delhi was in 1905. Thus, this revelation contained a prophecy that the person resembling him would travel to Delhi and people would hurl stones at him. I was the one, whom Allah had made to sit on the seat of the Promised Messiah (peace be on him), and who was made the target of stones. But Almighty Allah decreed that he would bring his resemblance, namely his back safelv... The expression "Who brought me safe indicates that there would be others who would suffer. (Tadhkirah pp. 769-770, Al-Fazl, vol. 32, No. 102, 3 May 1944, p. 5)

Pastors of Different Nature

It has generally been noticed that pastors are polite, sociable, and morally well-mannered. They respond with a smile even if one talks to them harshly. But some of them are very rude and uncourteous. Hazrat Mufti Muhammad Sadiq (may Allah be pleased with him) came in contact with an illmannered pastor in the United States. An incident happened when an Arab settled in the United States and married an American lady. The women, however, did not accept Islam and remained firm on Christianity. Once her Arab husband wrote a letter to Hazrat Mufti Sadiq and invited him to spend 2-4 days with him. Well, Mufti Sadiq went there and preached Islam to the lady. She said, "I can't answer you, but I call a pastor who will converse with you." Hazrat Mufti Sadiq said, "Yes, it is okay. You may call your pastor. "

So, the pastor came and the conversation started. Hazrat Mufti Sadiq said, "Respected Pastor! Atonement is problematic for me to understand in any way. Someone eats and fills the stomach of the

other. This is beyond human intellect." The pastor raged with anger and said with extreme infuriation, "If you do not believe in atonement, you will go to hell; yes, to hell."

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq replied softly, "Mr. Pastor! This morality is against the teachings of Jesus Christ that you demonstrated at this time. To go to hell, alas the hell is not in your control to throw whomever you want. Had the hell been in your control, you may say whatever you desired. But God is the custodian of it.

Seeing these harsh words uttered by the pastor for no reason, the lady became very annoyed and apologized to Hazrat Mufti Sadiq and said, "I did not know that he was so abusive, I wouldn't have otherwise called him. I am very ashamed."

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq said, "Do not think about it at all. We are accustomed to hearing such talks. Well, leave this matter aside and tell me if there is another pastor here." The lady said, "Yes! The pastor in the great church here, I think, is very worthy and learned."

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq met that pastor alone and introduced himself. The pastor treated Hazrat Mufti Sadiq with utmost respect and care and said, "Please take today's dinner with me." Hazrat Mufti Sadiq promised and went back. When he went to the feast in the evening, he noticed that the pastor and his wife had arranged a sumptuous feast and fed him the food with great care and ethics.

The next day Mufti Sadiq met another pastor in the market. The pastor said, "Can you stay here till Sunday?" Hazrat Mufti Sadiq replied, "Why are you enquiring about it?" The pastor responded, "I want you to deliver a lecture in our church on Sunday, if you can stay till Sunday and accept to lecture, I will be very grateful for this gesture." Hazrat Mufti Sadiq said, "I can only give lectures on Islam if you and your audience want to listen to it, then I am pleasurably ready to stay till Sunday."

The pastor said, "Of course, you give a lecture on Islam, we will learn new things about Islam from your lecture. Consequently, Hazrat Mufti Sadiq went to the church on Sunday and gave a lecture on Islam, to which all the people listened attentively and thanked him. After the lecture,

the pastor addressed the audience and said, "Dr. Mufti Sadiq has come after traveling a long distance, and on my request, he accepted to lecture here. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to help him with at least travel expenses. So, people donated some money and presented the collection to Mufti Sadiq.

Christian's Doctrine of Atonement

Anjuman Ahmadiyya Monghyr (Bengal) wanted to hold a large-scale convention in November 1910 and requested Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih I (may Allah be pleased with him) to send an elderly scholar from the center to Monghyr for participation in the convention. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih I ordered Maulānā Syed Sarwar Shah and Mufti Sadiq to go to Monghyr. On November 8, 1910, both of them left Qadian for Monghyr. The narrative of this journey is very interesting, but let us leave it and describe an interesting dialogue that Hazrat Mufti Sadiq had with an English priest on the platform of Lucknow Railway Station. Mufti Sadiq asked him, "If I am not making a mistake, are you a preacher of Christian faith?"

Pastor: I don't know Urdu.

This English pastor only knew that much Urdu to say that I did not know Urdu. So, Hazrat Mufti Sadiq started conversing with him in English.

Mufti Sadiq: Are you a preacher and proclaimer of the Christian faith?

Pastor: Yes, I am a pastor.

Mufti Sadiq: Can I enquire from you about anything religious?

Pastor: Yes, of course, ask. I will answer gladly.

Mufti Sadiq: I want to find out about the doctrine of atonement: Does Jesus' atonement only subject to the punishment for the sins of Christians that are to emanate after death or even the punishment in this world?

Pastor: Both types of punishments.

Mufti Sadiq: Well, now let us look at it practically, for example, when a Christian steals, he is sent to jail according to the law of the land. Although the government follows the Christian faith, it does not allow any concession to this Christian and imprisons him in the same way as a non-Christian thief. Now tell us what the benefit one got of the atonement in practice.

Pastor: Although when a Christian goes to jail and then repents, he receives such comfort and satisfaction that a non-Christian cannot get.

Mufti Sadiq: Regarding

satisfaction whoever repents and bows before God gets it. But we assume that the Christian gets the satisfaction, the non-Christian does not. When this was assumed, it proved that according to the practical benefit of atonement that emerged in this world, it will also happen in the next world, i.e., the Christian sinners will also be hurled into hell like non-Christians and both will be thrown into hell. The only difference will be that Christian sinners will be satisfied whereas non-Christian sinners will not.

On hearing this, the pastor leaned on the platform and looked far away at the rail track and then immediately left saying,

"Sorry, it's time for the train to arrive and I can't talk anymore."

But there were still fifteen minutes for the train to arrive.

Baptism

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq stated that Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih I (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated to me that a man went to a priest and said,

"I want to be baptized and become a Christian." But the condition is that you baptize me just as Jesus Christ did. Also, show me from the Gospel how Jesus Christ used to baptize so that I have no doubt."

On this strange question, the pastor surprisingly said,

"You cannot be baptized. Please go away."

The fact is that no one knows how Jesus Christ used to baptize.

In this regard, Hazrat Mufti Sadiq stated another interesting joke which was narrated to him by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih I (may Allah be pleased with him) which is as follows:

By chance in one village, two brothers got converted to Christianity and forced their old father to accept Christianity. The old man was ignorant and was unaware of the circumstances. He said to his sons,

"Well, just as you say. I am ready to be converted to Christianity."

The sons became very happy and went to the pastor and said,

"Our father wants to be a Christian, baptize him too."

The pastor said,

"It is a good omen. Bring him on Sunday."

So, both sons reached church on Sunday with their elderly father. The priest gladly agreed to baptize.

The procedure of baptism is: The priest sprinkles water three times on the face of the person who wants to be a Christian. On the first sprinkle, he says,

"I baptize you in the name of God, the Father."

And on the third sprinkle, he says,

"I baptize you in the name of the Holy Spirit."

The joke in this story is

described later. When the pastor sprinkled the splash on the old man's face for baptism, he uttered unintentionally:

(Translation: I bear witness that there is none worthy of worship except Allah. He is One and has no partner. And I bear witness that Muhammad is His Servant and Messenger.)

The reason for this was that the old man was accustomed that when he got up in the morning and washed his hands and face, he used to recite the second Kalima while splashing water on his face. He said the same Kalima at that time when water was sprinkled on his face. But the pastor was stunned hearing him and started thinking that the old man came here to be a Christian but recited the Kalima while being baptized. The pastor glanced at the two Christian sons. They were already very embarrassed and said,

"Pastor! Our father is an ignorant and uneducated man. The Kalima was pronounced from his mouth unintentionally. Don't think about this and start the proceeding

of baptism again."

Saying this, the two boys explained to the father, "Do not recite Kalima. Now forget Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him). Now salvation lies in believing Jesus Christ as God."

The old man replied, 'Okay."

After this, the pastor was ready to baptize him again, but as soon as he splashed water on the old man's face, he unconsciously recited the Kalima again.

Now there was no end to the pastor's anger. What would have been more anger, the voice of monotheism was raised with full force in the house of the trinity. In a great rage, the pastor ordered the two boys,

"Take away this old man, he can never be a Christian until the Day of Resurrection. He will die without getting salvation."

One day when he went there, he saw a gathering of people and a priest was standing there and preaching. Such scenes were seen there very commonly every day. Mufti Sadiq also stopped behind the gathered people to listen pastor's speech and after a few minutes, Mufti Sadiq said loudly,

"Pastor! I have a question. Will you please solve it?"

Most of the people in the gathering were women. When Mufti Sadiq asked this, they looked back and immediately turned around to make room for Mufti Sadiq. Mufti Sadiq passed through the gathering and stood next to the pastor. Then the pastor replied,

"I will answer your question with great pleasure. What is the question?"

There was a lot of interest in the people, and everyone eagerly waited for the mutual question and answer of Mufti Sadiq and the priest.

Mufti Sadiq asked,

"Pastor! The speech you were

delivering right now proved that God wanted children and He had a son. But what's the secret that He didn't have a daughter?"

The people present enjoyed this question of Hazrat Mufti Sadiq, especially women. The voices started coming from all corners that it was a valid question, and the pastor should definitely answer it.

Pastor: You are a thorough gentleman. Would you please tell me where you came from?

Audience: (With very loud voices) This is not the answer to the question, the pastor should answer this gentleman and not make useless

excuses.

Pastor: (Addressing a man who was speaking very loudly ahead of everybody) What did you do? He is asking, I shall rely. Why are you poking your nose in the matter for nothing?

Mufti Sadiq: Mr. pastor! I recommend that you fulfill the wishes of these people and answer my question.

Pastor: (Addressing Mufti Sadiq) You are not aware that he is actually a Jew and is speaking loudly ahead of everybody.

Mufti Sadiq: What is wrong if he is a Jew? I contemplate that you should be very grateful to the Jews, because if they had not crucified the "Son of God," Christians would not have got atonement. What do you think of it?

At this, there was loud laughter from the audience and the pastor turned blank and said,

"This is another new question you have asked."

Audience: Answer that too.

Mufti Sadiq: Answer one by one. First that question and later this.

Pastor: Do not heed what these people say: The Lord (Jesus Christ) has said.

"Let the dead bury their dead." (Luke 9:60)

Mufti Sadiq: Pastor! I am new to your city. I do not know the modus operandi here yet. Please explain to me whether when someone dies in a Christian country, he is not buried by those who are alive. Rather, do the dead come out of the graves and bury the new dead?

Pastor: That's the third question.

Audience: (unanimously) answer all three.

Pastor: You did not tell me where you are from.

Mufti Sadiq: I have arrived from India.

Pastor: Oh! It is a matter of great joy. My wife was also born in India.

Mufti Sadiq: Then she is my countrywoman. I will definitely meet her.

Audience: Mr. Pastor! Either answer the questions this gentleman has asked or say that you do not know the answers, so that time is not wasted for nothing.

Pastor: I am a very honest person. I can never lie. There is nothing wrong if I cannot reply. My wife is a very smart and learned woman. She will be able to answer these questions satisfactorily.

And one thing, people living in Europe do not know how to cook curry. My wife cooks very good curry.

Mufti Sadiq: It was even more heartening to hear this from you. Please tell me where can I find her.

Pastor: She often visits here. There is a sign for her. She can be recognized as she writes Bible verses on her hat. Here you will recognize her among hundreds of people when she visits.

Mufti Sadiq: I am not too smart to recognize. You take my address and introduce your wife to me at some appointed time. Moreover, what is your name?

Pastor: People call me "Old Joe."

Mufti Sadiq: Good night "Mr. Old Joe"

Saying this, Hazrat Mufti Sadiq left there and now the people started shouting that the pastor did not know the answers. Don't know what happened later?

Who is the Great Sinner?

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq published in Al-Fazl on 18 August 1917 a narrative of a debate with a pastor in Hyde Park London. The discussion is very interesting and enjoyable. So, listen to it. Hazrat Mufti Sadiq says:

I was having a debate with a Catholic priest in Hyde Park's resort on some religious issues. Hearing this, a gentleman who was later found to be a Protestant priest. He took me aside and said:

"You excellently made the pastor speechless. But I would like to tell you one thing."

I said:

"Say it, I shall be pleased."

He said:

"Behold, when Adam and Eve became sinners, the whole world also turned sinners. So, Muhammad (may peace and blessings of Allah be on him) was also a sinner. He cannot be our intercessor. But you believe that Jesus (peace be on him) is innocent."

I said:

"Sir, on what day did I write an agreement that Jesus is innocent?"

He said:

"Do you know him to be a

sinner?"

I said:

"It's a different matter if I know or not. But the philosophy that you have established is that all people are sinners because Adam and Eve were sinners. If this is to be believed, then tell me who according to your Bible was the first and greatest sinner? Adam or Eve?"

The priest said:

"Eve who was a woman."

I said:

"Well done! Then according to your principle, Mary (may peace be

on her), the children of Adam and Eve, was a sinner, and as Jesus was born only of a woman, he was more guilty than those born from a man, because the man is less sinful. The progeny is the average of both sides." At this, the pastor nervously ran away and managed to enter the crowd where a lecture was taking place. I ran after him, but he begged me to let him go now.

Who is a True Christian?

In 1926, when Mufti Sadiq was Nazir Umur-e-Kharja (Nazir foreign affairs), he had to go to Jalandhar for urgent work. On the way, he had an interesting debate with a Christian, the narrative of which is as follows in his words:

"When our Railway train was nearing Jalandhar, a priest was also sitting in the same apartment by chance and some religious conversation started with him. After a little discussion on the Bible and the Qur'an, the debate turned around in such a way that who is the true Christian?

The pastor said that Christians are true due to their beliefs in the Trinity and Atonement. I said that we Muslims are true Christians who believed in Hazrat Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be on him) according to the prophecy of

Hazrat 'Isa (peace be on him), and then accepted the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him).

I said that acceptance is not only by tongue but is by practical means. One of the essential commandments of Christ of Nazareth is to give whatever anyone demands from you. Therefore, because of this commandment, I ask you to give me a small booklet of the Bible you are holding in your hand. Give me this book to fulfill the commandment of Jesus. So, I will understand that you are honoring the commandment of Jesus from the bottom of your heart. But the pastor flatly refused to hand over the Gospel (Bible).

Then I said, Listen, pastor! Whatever I have right now, you can ask me without any hesitation, I will immediately hand that to you without fail. Let us see what you ask

from me.

In fact, I had told to the pastor with great honesty and with the good intention that whatever I had at that time, I would hand it over to him whatever he asked without any contemplation. I wanted to show the apparent difference between a Muslim and a Christian to the people who were traveling in the rail apartment at that time and were listening to both of us with great interest and great attention. But to my surprise, neither the pastor handed me his book nor dared to ask something from me.

On this, his companions themselves embarrassed him and the matter was ended.

Different Dealings in Worldly Matters and Religion

Hazrat Mufti Sadiq was in London when one day he was passing through the market of London with a friend when his friend noticed a signboard of a shop that read:

"Trinity Book Shop"

That is, the "Library of the Holy Trinity." It was a book sale shop of the pastors. Mufti Sadiq's friends knew what it meant, but unknowingly he asked a pastor sitting in the shop, "What do you mean by the Trinity?"

Pastor: The Trinity means: "The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. All three are Gods. But God is only one not three. It is a spiritual secret

that three are one and one is three."

On this, Mufti Sadiq explained to the pastor that what you said is absolutely wrong in principle. It can never be that three are one, and one is three.

The conversation continued. The pastor remained adamant on his words and so did the Mufti Sadiq. When the conversation prolonged, Hazrat Mufti Sadiq took a book from a nearby table, on which the price tag was worth three shillings, and said to the pastor:

"Sir! I want to buy this book." Pastor: It will be my pleasure. Sadiq: What is its price? Pastor: Three Shillings.

Mufti Sadiq smilingly took a Shilling out of his pocket, extended his hand to the pastor, and said:

"Take its price."

The pastor saw a Shilling and said:

Sir! You probably are not aware. I had submitted that it cost three Shillings.

Sadiq: There is nothing wrong. Three are one and one is three. So, accept this one.

Pastor: (Laughs) Sir, worldly dealing is separate and for religion it is altogether different.

Sadiq: It is a strange religion

that worldly matters become different. Mr. pastor! If you study the religion of Islam, you will see that it remains the same in every situation even if we are in the Market or the mosque.














Al-Ḥājj Jameel Ghuari was born and named Charles "Chuck" Chambliss on November 24, 1952, to the late Charlie and Annie Mae (Lindsey) Chambliss. He graduated from Washington Park High School as one of its top Basketball players and went on to play at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside where he was inducted into the Hall of Fame. He eventually was able to travel overseas to play professionally in Scotland, Japan, Canada, and the Philippines.

He was raised in a very religious family and grew to be one who was always curious about his faith. While at Parkside, he met Muslims and was interested in Islam but due to their ill conduct, he didn't pursue it, but remained interested in Islam. When he later went to Scotland to play, he had more time and fewer distractions and decided to go on a spiritual quest. During this time, he also studied Buddhism, but his attraction to Islam remained the strongest. Eventually, he looked up the local mosque in the phone book and called. It happened to be an Ahmadi Mosque, the first mosque built in England, and the phone was answered by Brother Bashir Ahmad Orchard, the first European to accept Ahmadiyyat. Brother Bashir invited him to come and meet with

him, which he did, and continued to do so. He would go to practice in the morning, then catch the train to go to the mosque in the afternoon and stay until after 'Ishā. Eventually, Brother Jameel accepted Ahmadiyyat and became one of the first if not the first American convert to Ahmadiyyat in Europe. It was at this time that Brother Jameel received his name from Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih III (may Allah shower His mercy on him), and also performed Hajj in the early 1980s.

With basketball as his craft and Ahmadiyyat as his foundation, he was able to travel the world and enhance the lives of young people. Some his of athletic accomplishments include being a stand-out player at Park High School, then playing at UW-Parkside, and later competing at a professional level in Scotland, Japan, Canada, and the Philippines. After returning home he served as Director of the Bray Center, a community center in inner-city Racine where he shared his knowledge and experience about the game of basketball with others. He trained countless athletes, some of whom made it to the professional level.

By the grace of Allah, Brother Jameel held some local Zion Jamā'at Amila and Ansarullah positions.

In 2015 and 2016 Jameel organized and ran the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community's Urban Youth Basketball camps at the Bray Center. In 2016 he arranged for the community's international sports tournament (MIST) to be held at the Bray Center. In 2018, he along with Daud Ahmad of Racine were invited to the MIST Tournament in Miami to hold a spiritual training session on the subject of dealing with the ills of

Western society as requested by the organizers.

His passion for faith and basketball allowed him to touch countless lives and leave behind a legacy of family and service that can serve as an example for all those aspiring to serve their communities. At different points he held leadership positions in his local chapter of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, serving the Jamā'at as a local elected official.

During his life, Bro. Jameel met and interacted with many famous people, but made it clear that these meetings paled in comparison to meeting the Khalifa of the time, and he had the honor of meeting Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih III, IV, and V on several occasions.

On 23 October 2023, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community of Zion helped lay to rest a long-time pioneer member of the Zion Jamā'at and servant to the Racine Community, Al-Hajj Jameel Ghuari. He passed away peacefully at Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital in Milwaukee on 18 October 2023. Inna Lillāhi Wa Innā Ilaihi Raji'oon. [(Surely, to Allah we belong, and to Him shall we return. (Al-Baqarah 2:157)]

He is survived by three sons, Myron McNutt, Sharif Chambliss, and Isiah Scales, and his daughter Huriyyah Ghuari, and many grandchildren. Also surviving are his three brothers Donald Robinson, Carl "Trick" Robinson, and Mark Chambliss, and his Ahmadiyya Muslim Family. May Allah grant him forgiveness and peace and allow his good deeds to continue to be a source of blessings for all that he has impacted, Amen! Sana Siddiqui and Zeenath Malik, Isha'at Desk-Lajna Ima'illah Virginia North

My great-grandfather, Captain Naimatullah Siddiqui embraced Ahmadiyyat when he was only twenty-five. He happened to visit his maternal aunts in Oadian. There, he had the opportunity to sit and have dinner with Hazrat Mirza Bashir-ud-Din Mahmud Ahmad Khalifatul-Masih II (may Allah be pleased with him) and his companions. He was so impressed by the affection of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be pleased with him), the kindness of the people and the pious atmosphere of Qadian, that he decided to enter into the fold of Ahmadiyyat. He wrote a letter to Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be pleased with him) stating his wish to join Islam Ahmadiyyat. Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be pleased with him) wrote back to him in the same letter and asked him to seek permission from his father first. My great-grandfather then asked his father for permission to join Islam Ahmadiyyat. His father resonated with his feelings and told him that he believed in Islam Ahmadiyyat too and had been thinking about joining them. At the age of 25, my grandfather undertook bait. Soon after, he went to join the merchant navy and became captain.


My great-grandfather had a very

strong relationship with God. He was very punctual in his prayers and never missed any. Every night, he would call all of us to perform Maghrib and 'Ishā prayers in the congregation. He would always go to Jumu'a wearing his freshly ironed shalwar kameez. He would read the Holy Quran daily. He would always advise us to tell the truth no matter what and I never heard him telling a lie even as a joke in all his life. He said that God loved those people who were always honest. He believed that God rewarded those who had made financial sacrifices. He was very regular and generous in his Chanda payments. He even continued to pay Chanda for his late mother and father in their names. He would secretly give financial help to those who needed money but wouldn't ask for it. One of his strongest beliefs was belief in the power of praying to God. He always told us to pray, and he prayed for all his kids and his grandkids and their kids. He even prayed for everyone he knew. I never saw him worry ever in his life, he was always happy and content no matter what because of his relationship with God. He knew God would always help him in any situation. I would always hear him say Al-Hamdu-Lilah and Istighfar-Allah numerous times a day. He was always very grateful even for the smallest thing God gave him.

My great-grandfather's love and lovalty to Khilafat was immense. He was initiated into the Electoral College for the election of a Khalifa. He was called to attend the meeting for the electoral college after the death of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih III (may Allah shower His mercy on him) for the election of his successor. He was on duty in the navy as a Captain and could not attend the meeting. Again in 2003, after the demise of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (may Allah shower His mercy on him), he was called to London for a meeting of the electoral college. He left for London immediately. He said that he had already made up his mind to vote for a certain person. When the proceedings started, different people were nominated for Khilafat. All those people would get up when their names were called. When Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (may Allah be His helper) got up, my great-grandfather noticed that there was so much Godly light emanating from his face that he immediately decided to vote for him. He was not the only one to witness this godliness of Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V (may Allah be His helper), almost all the

hands went up in his favor. Allah SWT had put his name in their hearts at that very moment. It not only shows his true love and devotion to Khilafat but also his piety.

My great-grandfather had the greatest and the sincerest love for his family. He was so loving and kind that he never raised his voice or even got mad at anyone no matter what they did. He would laugh and smile with everyone. He had a very happy and jovial disposition that was reflected in him until his last moments in life. He respected everyone and showed utmost hospitality towards those who would visit him. He stressed the importance of honesty and education before his kids. He lived his daily life on a set schedule and always made his bed well into his 90s. He always kept everything very organized and clean. In his later years, his favorite thing was to look at picture albums of his family that he had made with immense love throughout his life. Those who saw him or met him would always say that he was one of the best people they ever came across. I feel blessed to say that Captain Naimatullah Siddiqui was my great-grandfather.


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Having no place to stay, I would routinely show up
