## LETTER TO THE WASHINGTON POST EMANCIPATION OF WOMAN AND ISLAM

The Parade section of the Washington Post, June 7, 1981 under Intelligence has carried out a news item with the caption SORRY NOW.

It seems the writer of the Intelligence has tried in the footsteps of Joseph Kraft to expose his selfconceived "the dark side of Islam."

It is absolutely inconsistent with the so-considered advanced culture of the Western society that their information on Islam should come through adulterated channels from the hands of the propagandists hostile to Islam; and in this respect, I must assure the readers, that misconception, or even misconstrution of Islam and its tenets is not our complaint. It is misrepresentation and misinformation, by which we are the chief sufferers. Things having no existence whatsoever in our teachings and polity have been imputed to us, and baseless charges advanced against Islam. nay, the very beauties which we account amongst our exclusive possessions have been denied to us. and the very evils which Islam came to eradicate, and did succeed in doing so, are ascribed to it. The same applies here.

The writer distorting the true picture of Islam has laboriously presented the emancipation and equality of woman as paradoxical to Islam and its tenets.

Before the advent of Islam, women had no position in society. They were at the mercy and caprice of the menfolk and were treated as goods and chattles. It was Islam that, for the first time, vindicated the rights of women and gave them a status unknown and even unthought of to this day. They are granted all the fundamental rights. They are given the right of inheritance of the property of their father, mother, husband, son, daughter, and brothers.

The Holy Quran emphasizes that God in His perfect wisdom has created all species in pairs, and so men and women have been created of the same species; as is said:

"O mankind be mindful of your duty to your Lord, Who created you from a single soul and from it created its mate and from the two created mates for you of your own kind that you may find peace of mind through them, and He has put love and tenderness between you. In that surely are Signs for a people who reflect." (30:22).

Some religious disciplines mistakenly esteem celibacy more exalted spiritually than conjugal life. Islam disapproves of celibacy and condemns it. The Holy Quran says: "They devised monasticism as a means of seeking Allah's pleasure. We do not prescribe it for them, and they did not observe it duly." (57:28)

The whole concept of monasticism originated in the notion that woman was an inferior type of creation and association with her was degrading and demoralizing. The Church Fathers laid the responsibility of man's fall upon woman, and represented her as being without soul and an instrument of the devil. Islam denounced this attitude, and raised woman to a position of spiritual equality with man. It held that man and woman complemented each other and were a means of mutual fulfillment. For instance, it is said:

"They (women) are a garment for you and you are a garment for them." (2:188). We all know that we wear clothes to cover our bodies and to hide our nakedness. Another purpose of wearing them is to protect our bodies from heat and cold. In the same way the husband and the wife must act as a cover fo each other's weaknesses and shortcomings and for each other's honor and chastity.

Woman's spiritual equality with man is repeatedly stressed in the Holy Quran. For instance it is said:

"For men who submit themselves wholly to Allah, and women who submit themselves wholly to Him and men who believe and women who believe, and men who obey Allah and women who obey Him, and men who are truthful and women who are truthful, and men who are steadfast and women who are steadfast, and men who are humble and women who are humble, and men who give alms and women who give alms, and men who fast and women who fast, and men who guard their chastity and women who guard their chastity, and men who remember Allah much and women who remember Him, Allah has prepared forgiveness and a great reward." (33:36)

Men and woman will be equally rewarded in the hereafter: "Whoso does good whether male or female, and is a believer, shall enter Paradise and they shall not be wronged a whit." (4:125)

Talk of Islam's failure to adjust to modernity is usually based on Western definitions and concepts of "modernization" and "progress." We Muslims say that modernization does not have to mean Westernization and secularization. Islam is not against modernization. But when modernization aims at fulfilling only materialistic needs while disregarding moral matters, it always ends up breaking down the structure of society.

Unfortunately the West no longer considers chastity a virtue, indeed it has become a reproach. Experimental living together and promiscuity have become the norm. Perversion and sensuality, inside and outside wedlock, are deemed the true purpose and object of sex. Woman has been degraded into a mere instrument for sexual indulgence. According to Islam the relationship between husband and wife should be characterized by grace. The Holy Quran says:

"Consort with them graciously. If you dislike them, it may be that you dislike something in which Allah has placed much good." (4:20)

Husbands and wives have reciprocal obligations towards each other, but as man is the breadwinner and has the responsibility of providing for wife and family, in case of difference in the matter of running the household he has the final word, lest things should get out of hand and the family should be faced with ruin:

"Wives have rights corresponding to those which husbands have, in equitable reciprocity, though, in certain situations, men would have the final word and they enjoy a preference, Allah is Mighty, Wise."(2:229) On account of the physical weakness and delicacy of women and their vulnerability, men are appointed guardian over women:

"Men are appointed guardians over women, because of that in respect of which Allah has made some of them excel others, and because the men spend of their wealth. So virtuous women are obedient and safeguard, with Allah's help, matters the knowledge of which is shared by them with their husbands." (4:35)

The Western civilization claims to "emancipate" women only to exploit her as the means for destroying the home and the family. Most devastating, however, is the ever-increasing freedom for illicit sex. No effort is spared to exploit and commercialize the female body. The result can be seen in the skyrocketing rise in the number of divorces, abortions, unmarried mothers, teenage pregnancies, illegitimate children, sex crimes and cases of veneral diseases.

Here are the statistics mostly published in the Washington Post which show the result of that "emancipation" of which the writer of the Intelligence is advocating for the Muslim women, and for which he asserts that the Iranian women are SORRY NOW:

"More American marriages than ever broke up in 1979 as the number of divorces nearly trippled what it was 20 years before, the government reported yesterday. Some 1.18 million divorces were granted in 1979, 4.5 percent more than the 1.13 million of 1978, and almost three times the 395,000 granted in 1959, according to the National Center for Health Statistics." (The Washington Post, June 9, 1981). 2. "Approximately 1.3 million adult men and women lived together as unmarried heterosexual couples in 1976, according to the Census Bureau. The number doubled from 1970, when 654,000 unmarried men and women shared households." (The Washington Post, May 28, 1977). Now the number must have increased manyfold.

3. "More than half of the children born to Washington residents in 1975 were born out of wedlock.... Overall, 4,988 children were born to unmarried women in Washington in 1975 compared to 4,758 born to married women. Nationwide, about 13% of all children are born to unmarried women, a proportion that has been increasing steadily since 1963." (The Washington Post, November 11, 1976).

4. A Washington Post December 1976 Editorial presents the problem in this way: "As those U. S. pregnancies suggest, U. S. teenagers are sexually active. Indeed, half the 21 million teenagers have intercourse at some time before age 19, and a fifth of the nation's 13 to 14 year olds have had intercourse at least once.... One of the principal results is that a million teenagers a year become pregnant and 600,000 give birth."(The Washington Post, December 11,1976). 5. According to the Washington Post, April, 1977: "Last fiscal year, 1,011,014 cases of gonorrhea were reported to the U. S. Public Health Service, an increase of 25.4% since 1965 and the highest number since the PHS started keeping such records 55 years ago."

6. "There were 76,736 cases of syphilis reported to the PHS during FY 1976 and it is estimated that at least 360,000 more untreated cases occurred in the United States last year..." (The Washington Post, April 17, 1977).

7. According to the report "Gonorrhea which often leads to sterility affected some 22 million last year, accounting for 1.2 million hospital days and costing society some \$229 million. Likewise the institutional care of people suffering from syphilitic psychosis cost taxpayers \$60 million last year." (The Washington Post, April 17, 1977.).

In the early days of Islam women enjoyed full liberty, joined congregational prayers with men and played their full part in the progress and advancement of their nation. Even sometime they accompanied men in wars and performed the following duties:

1. They carried away the wounded from the battlefield, 2. nursed them; 3. those who died, buried them; 4. supervised the kitchen of the army; 5. revived the spirits of the soldiers by reciting heroic verses, very often composed by themselves. The rigour of Purdah was considerably lessened to facilitate the performance of their beneficient duties as nurses.

Islamic history is full of brilliant Muslim women. The wife of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of God be upon him) namely Ayesha, became one of the greatest jurist, traditionist, commentatoress and genealogist of her day. Ayesha knew medicine also and well versed in all Arabic literature and poetry. Sakina daughter of Husain the Martyr, was a lady of great scholarly reputation. In Spain, even ladies entered the lists as votaries of the muse. Valadata, daughter of Khalifa of Cordova, "endowed with equal beauty and genies" was considered as the Arabian Sappho. Labena also a native of that far famed capital, not only excelled as a poetess, but was deeply skilled in philosophy and arithmetic, and held an office of private secretary to the Khalifa Hakim.

Muslim ladies physicians and jurists have both been of great renown. Zubaidah, the wife of famous Haroon Rashid of Bagdad and Nur-Jehan the wife of Jehangir, Emperor of India have both played a very important role in the history of theirs. Muslim Queens have successfully governed countries and empires. It was through Islam, more than anything else, that the woman found an illimitable scope for demonstrating her capabilities. One frequently comes across, in Islamic history feminine names noted in the arts of peace as well as wars.

I made a presentation for 45 minutes on "Religion and Sexuality" at the Wright State University, Dayton, Ohio, on April 23, 1981. ## Washington, D. C.:

A unique function sponsored by the Washington branch of Lajna Ima Ullah was held here at the American Fazl Mosque on Sunday, June 14, 1981.

NAIB SADR'S LETTER TO KHUDDAM 

Dear Brother, Assalamo alaikum

I hope, by the grace of Allah, you are keeping well. At the last Annual Iitima of Majlis Kuddamul Ahmadivva which was held at the end of the 14th and beginning of the 15th Century, the Majlis requested Hazrat Khalifatul Masih to allow them to seek permission for building two mosques. Hazur very graciously accepted the request of the Majlis and subsequently an announcement was made by the Sadr Mailis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya at the time of the Annual Ijtima.

To welcome the 15th Hijra and to achieve the blessings of Allah and to seek His guidance for the forthcoming triumph of Islam, Majlis will Inshallah erect two mosques; one in Italy and the other in Latin America.

These Mosques will be built by contributions purely from the Khuddams of Europe, America and Canada. This project will Inshallah be completed in two years. Each Khadim will be required to pay at least \$150 while each tifl (child) will contribute at least \$35 towards this project. This money must be paid within ten months.

1. Alhaj Ata Ullah Kaleem the Imam of the American Fazl Mosque addressed the students and a few members of the staff of the Southeastern University on "A Short Sketch of Islam." He has so far addressed the Majalis Ansarullah of New York, Boston, Willingboro, Philadelphia, and Washington, D. C. and has exhorted the members to activate their activities. On the request of the Missionary-in-Charge U. S. A. he has given the following message for the Ansarullah in U. S. A. Ed.).

### Dear Members of Ansarullah of U. S. A. Assalamo Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barakatuhoo

The Missionary Incharge has desired that if I had some message for the Ansars in U. S. A. Our foremost duty is to study the Holy Quran, the Hadith, and the books written by the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him). Secondly we should try to mould our lives strictly according to the teachings contained therein. Thirdly, we should try our utmost to upbring our children in the true Islamic spirit.

Always keep in view the following words of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him):

"A mere verbal pledge has no value if it is not supported by a genuine and firm resolve to live up to it in every way. Therefore, whoever fully lives up to my teachings, he alone enters that house of mine with reference to which God Almighty has promised -INNEE UHA-FIZO KULLA MAN FID DARI-i.e. "I shall Myself protect all those who are in this house."
