

MESSAGE OF HAZRAT KHALIFATUL MASIH ON THE OCCASION OF THE 37TH U.S. AHMADIYYA ANNUAL CONVENTION

(The message was conveyed to the participants of the conention by Sheikh Mubarak Ahmad, the Amir and Missionary Incharge, in his inaugural address.)

My loving brethren in Ahmadiyyat

Assalamo Alaikum

It gives me great pleasure to learn that the Annual Convention of the US Ahmadiyya Community is being held at Madison, Wisconsin, from the 2nd to 4th of August 1985. May Allah bless this gathering and bestow His bounties and mercies on all the participants and may Allah prove it to be a milestone for the spiritual revolution of Islam for the entire world.

On this auspicious occasion, when the devotees of Ahmadiyyat have gathered from all over America, I wish to communicate the following message:

In the history of the world, it has been established that the only revolutionary Prophet was our most beloved and master, the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be on him), through whose powerful inspiration and spiritual motivation, a very strange and great spiritual change occured in the early days of Islam. In the same way it was destined that a great spiritual revolution should occur in the latter days. That was the object of the advent of the Promised Messiah and his divine mission.

In the early days of his advent, when he was informed through a revelation from God, the Promised Messiah wrote in his book *Fatahe Islam* (Victory of Islam):

"Islam will rise once again to its zenith as it did in the past, and once again its sun will shine with the

AHMADIYYA MISSIONARY IN TRINIDAD MURDERED

On the evening of August 10, 1985, at about 8:30 p.m., Imam Muhammad Aslam Qureshi was returning from the home of a fellow Ahmadi member when he was stopped on his way back to the mission house by some men in two cars and a jeep. A pistol was placed against his forehead and he was shot and killed on the spot. His assailants escaped and have not yet been caught by the police. Imam Qureshi was a young man with a wife and three children

Previously, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Mission House in Norway was bombed in recent weeks. It appears that the present Martial Law administration in Pakistan is escalating its attacks against the Ahmadiyya Movement in Islam in areas outside of Pakistan. Representatives of the administration recently held a meeting in London at which time anti-Ahmadiyya statements were made to the press.

same force and brightness as it did in the earliest days."

The Promised Messiah further said:

"That day is not far off when you will witness yourselves the forces of angels descending and penetrating into the hearts of people of Asia, Europe and America."

Later, in 1904, the Promised Messiah declared:

"I see that from the day of my advent, from that very moment, a great revolution is taking place in

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Europe and America. Those who believed Jesus to be the son of God, their scholars and researchers are forsaking this belief. Those nations whose forefathers were worshipping idols and false dieties, most of them have now come to realize that their idols are valueless. And those who are devoid of spiritual powers, although they have discarded some of the useless traditions and no more indulge in *Shirk* (Associating partners with God), are at the threshold of God. Only a little push would take them to heaven where they will be enriched with perfect love of God. It is not my own conjecture but it is revealed to me by God.''

I am noticing the fulfillment of these heavenly tidings in the near future. It must be remembered that in order to bring this great spiritual revolution, every Ahmadi of America-man or woman-should strive hard to bring about this revolution. Every one of you should be a Da'ee Ilallah and propagate with more zeal and vigor. That is the only way that the spiritual revolution can be brought yet closer. Every one of you should hold the banner of Ahmadiyyat and convev its teachings to every nook and corner of America-to every inhabitant of America, regardless whether he is a Red Indian or any other American national, an alien or an immigrant. A special effort is required for Pakistanies who are living in America because Pakistan is the country where millions of Ahmadies live and where its International Headquarters are located. We shouls also pray for the solidarity of Pakistan because millions of people laid their lives and shed their blood for its creation.

I am confident that all the members of Jamaat Ahmadiyya of America, men and women, old and young, with solemn prayers to God and seeking His help, will undertake with new vigor and zeal the task of propagation of Islam. This propagation should be fruitful. You should not take respite till such time that the results are visible in the form of your spiritual progeny.

In the end I pray to Allah, in the words of the Promised Messiah (peace be on him):

"O God! who is Omnipotent, we wish to witness the time when people of this earth will stop worshipping their false dieties and they would worship You and You alone; and this earth is filled with those who are truthful and Your believers only and those who believe in the grandeur of Your honored Messenger, the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of God be on him). Such believers shold fill the earth as the sea is full of water. Ameen."

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SUMMARY OF THE FRIDAY SERMON OF HAZRAT KHALIFATUL MASIH IV Delivered on June 7, 1985, at the Fazl Mosque, London

The year 133 Hijra carries great significance in the history of Islam, when two great Islamic empires were founded-in the East the Abbaside empire, and in the West a strong state by Abdur Rahman the First. Till 172 Hijra when Abdur Rahman died the empire made tremendous progress, but right after his death the first mutiny against the Muslim rule occurred sponsored by the Mullah. The Muslim empire in Spain ended in 1491 Hijra when the Muslims were banished from Spain-the destruction of the Muslim empire was caused as the result of a conspiracy of the Mullah. If the Mullahs, the so-called Ulema, had not caused disorder and dissension through revolts and mutiny, the western countries would have been Muslim areas. The Maliki Ulema caused havoc for the western Muslim empire, and in the East the empire based in Baghdad was destroyed through Shia-Sunni conflicts-caused by the Mullah. The empire was destroyed with the invasion of Halaku Khan from the north, who was invited by the Prime Minister, Ibne Alquami, of the last King, Motisim Billah, who acted hand and glove with the Shia Ulema to destroy the kingdom. More than ten million Muslims were killed only in Baghdad. Mosques were desecrated. Azaan was prohibited. Halaku Khan was the first ever man in the Islamic history to ban Azaan. This is the character of the Mullah, who is responsible for the collosal destruction of two great Islamic empires. Had they not been destroyed, greater regions of the present day world would have been Islamic, as a result of the preaching of righteous Muslim saints.

How can you recognize this dangerous *Mullah?* How can you distinguish him from the saintly righteous Ulema? One of the clear signs by which the wicked Mullah can be recognized is that he is totally unaware of the dangers posed from outside, but has thousand eyes to see the dangers from inside—nay not the real dangers which may be present. He is least interested to combat immorality. Injustice, cruelty, killings, corruption, ignorance. Lack of moral values does not stir him a bit. He always warns against the dangers which are non-existant. He warns the Muslims against Muslims. He causes dissension and disunity. In fact he himself is the greatest threat for Islam and for the Muslims.

Today the Muslim world is threatened with the curse of Mullaism. It is the Mullah who raised the

slogan of irreligious Sultan in Malaysia. It is the Mullah who is causing great disorder in Pakistanthe Wahabi Mullah is hitting the very foundations of Pakistan. But the politicians there are totally disillusioned. The history of Mullaism is like an open book, and reveals nothing but total destruction of nations at its hand, but Pakistani politicians do not conceive of it. All the military regimes in Pakistan came to power only through Mullaism. Many other countries which got their independence at the same time when Pakistan was created, have gone too far ahead of Pakistan in every respect, but it is only because of the Mullah that Pakistan could not attain a respectable position in the world. The leaders of Pakistan should realize this fact that Pakistan is going to face the fate of Baghdad and Spain if Mullaism is not done away with.

ZAFRULLAH KHAN PASSES AWAY

It is announced with deep sorrow that one of the very prominent and active members of the Ahmadiyya Movement in Islam, Sir Muhammad Zafrullah Khan, passed away on September 1, 1985. Inna Lillahe Wa Inna Ilaihe Raajeoon.

He was a man of international fame as a lawyer, a politician and as a judge. He was the first Foreign Minister of Pakistan. He resigned that post in 1954 to accept appointment as a judge at the International Court of Justice where he served for many years as a judge and later as the president of the International Court of Justice. He was also the president of the United Nations General Assembly in 1964.

His contributions to the cause of Ahmadiyyat are no less significant. He never left ay opportunity pass by to serve Ahmadiyyat. He wrote many books and translated many of the works of the Promised Messiah.

Shortly after Hazrat Mirza Tahir Ahmad was elected Khalifatul Masih IV, Huzur saw in a vision that Sir Zafrullah Khan was conversing with God. God asked him how many years will it take him to complete his work. To this he answered that it will take four years but if he was given one year, it may also suffice.

For one year after this vision of Haszrat Khalifatul Masih JV, Sir Zafrullah Khan worked actively. Then (continued on page 11)

"ISLAM ACKNOWLEDGES THE RIGHT OF EVERY PERSON TO PROFESS HIS FAITH."

"The situation in Pakistan deserves to be condemned."

(Begum Ra'ana Liaquat Ali Khan)

The following is a press statement issued by Begum Ra'ana Liaquat Ali Khan, the widow of the first Prime Minister of Pakistan, Khan Liaquat Ali Khan. She is a former Governor of the Province of Sind and the Founder and Life President of All Pakistan Women Association (APWA).

"During the past one year newspapers have reported occasional murders of Ahmadi notables in mysterious circumstances. More recently hundreds of arrests have been made of members of this peaceloving Community. Those arrested have been reportedly subjected to physical torture, while the charge against them is usually that of wearing Kalima Tayyaba Badges. This situation deserves to be condemned forthrightly without any reservations.

It is known history that while the Ahmadiyya Community supported the cause of Pakistan, most of the mullah community, their present persecutors, opposed the creation of Pakistan tooth and nail. The two great Quaids appreciated the contribution of Ahmadies towards the Muslim cause and recognized it by appointing Ch. Mohammad Zafarullah Khan as the first Foreign Minister of Pakistan. In those great days Pakistan had not been reduced to a theocratic state, and not only Muslims, regardless of their auxiliary beliefs, but even Hindus were given Cabinet posts. The rights of minorities and small groups were not paid just the lip service but were protected with deliberate effort.

How can this expression of faith in the Prophet

Mohammad (peace be upon him), expressed by wearing the Kalima Tayyaba badges, be made a punishable offence in an Islamic State? Islam acknowledges the right of every person to profess his faith. It is indeed heart rendering to see the most un-Islamic acts committed in the very name of Islam. There could be no greater disservice to this great religion. One does not need great intellect to discern that if such irrational policy can be adopted today towards Ahmadies, there is no guarantee that other sects will not be subjected tomorrow to equally cruel and unethical measures. Further, it is grossly objectionable, indeed downright immoral, to forcibly disturb the fundamental political understanding that existed at the time of creation of Pakistan between the new state and its component peoples. That understanding is the bedrock of our state and nobody has the sanction to erode it.

I urge all sections of society to protest against all forms of oppression and tyranny. Acts of grace and courage like supporting the rightful cause of women, minorities, small ethnic and religious groups, off-thebeaten-track intellectuals and outside-the-establishment politicians will ensure that human rights are respected and freedom of speech, faith and assembly is enjoyed by one and all. In the absence of these, the political fabric of our state will disintegrate; the consequences of which will be most disastrous.

HUMAN RIGHTS GROUP ACCUSES PAKISTAN OF TORTURE AND ABUSES

WASHINGTON, July 24, Reuter. Pakistan leader Zia-ul-Haq's military government has been torturing prisoners, holding people incommunicado without trial, and discriminating against religious minority groups: according to a report by a U.S. human rights group released today.

The report by the lawyers committee for human rights, based on an invetigation by two former U.S. officials, said Washington had failed to put enough pressure on Islamabad to curb abuses. The United States, seeking to bolster Pakistan against what it regads as a threat from Soviet forces in neighboring Afghanistan, is providing Islamabad with military aid.

"Prisoners, particularly those detained on political grounds, are brutally treated (and) beatings and torture are frequent," the report said.

"Incommunicado detention is a regular feature of the regime—many prisoners have been detained for years without charge or trial," it said.

A Pakistan Embassy spokesman later telephoned

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reuters today with a statement terming the report, "a catalogue of unsubstantiated allegations which have not been sourced. Many of the allegations had been denied previously," he said.

The report deliberately minimizes the strides made in Pakistan for the restoration of democracy," the statement said.

"It exemplifies the tendency among intellectuals of a particular persuasion to apply different standards to conservative, pro-West governments, on the one hand, and to the so-called liberal and anti-West regimes on the other," it concluded.

Religious minority groups such as the Ahmadies sect have been subjected to systematic, extensive discrimination, according to the study.

It said the Ahmadies are a sect of Islam but the Pakistan government, under pressure from conservative mainstream clerics, had passed laws calling for prison sentences and fines if an Ahmadi described himself as a Moslem.

The report was based on a month-long investigation in Pakistan by lawyers Matthew Nimetz, a former U.S. undersecretary of state, and Charles Lister, a one-time U.S. air force official.

The two interviewed more than 300 Pakistanies, many of whom requested anonymity and described being tortured or beaten while in prisons, according to the report. The lawyers continued to gather testimony in the United States this year.

The study quoted former prisoners as saying they had been deprived of sleep or beaten for days on end, subjected to electric shocks, and incarcerated in "tiger cages."

The cages are smaller than the size of one man, prohibiting any body movement at all," it said.

It said the most common form of torture appeared to be "tying prisoners to racks, with rollers moved along the body under the weight of several men."

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PERSECUTION OF AHMADIES IN PAKISTAN CONTINUES

ANOTHER AHMADI MARTYRED

SUKHAR (Kot Abdu): It is announced with great regret that this morning Mr. Inaa'mur Rahman Anwar, son of the late Maulvi Abdul Rahman Anwar, who was in Government service at "kot Abdu" near Sukkhar has been martyred

Mr. Inaa'mur Rahman Anwar was walking along a busy bazar of Sukkhar when he was brutally attacked with knives and was shot several times. He died instantly. However, by the Grace of Allah, his wife and family are safe. Necessary assistance has been rushed to Sukhar from Karachi, Hydrabad and Nawabshah. There is no justification for this cold-blooded murder.

In May 1984 the then Ameer of Sukkhar, the late Qureshi Abdul Rahman Sahib, aged 73 was martyred. On January 28, 1985, an attempt was made on the life of Mr. Najmul Haq, Ameer Jamaat Sukkhar. He was also stabbed with a knife. No arrests have so far been made in any of the abovementioned cases.

Since the promulgation of the Ordinance the lives of the members of the Ahmadiyya Community are in constant danger and the authorities have failed to take any constructive action to protect them.

SEALING OF MOSQUES AT NAWABSHAH:

Mr. Rasul Bux Baloch, the then D.C., Nawabshah (at present D.C. Tharparkar) sealed two Mosques at Nawabshah.

ii) Libraries were also sealed and even Ahmadies were not allowed to read their own books.

iii) Criminal cases were registered against two Ahmadies who had gifted a piece of land for the construction of Mosque in 1981. Cases were registered in 1984.

iv) Under the orders of the then D.C. Nawabshah. The Daily Alfazal was banned and the Post Office was directed not to deliver it to the Ahmadies.

v) In Bandhi the Mehrab of the Mosque was sealed. vi) The Ahmadies settled in Abaro were chased in such a manner that they could not continue their businesses and left the city.

ARRESTS ON BASELESS CHARGES

Uptill now 78 Ahmadis have been arrested from Kunri, Nasirabad, Talhi, Mehmoodabad, Nabi Sar Road, Naokot, Bandhi and Badin on concockted charges. For example:

i) Two Ahmadis have been arrested on the accusation they were preaching Ahmadiyyat. Their fault, if any,

is that on an invitation card, they wrote:

و علے عدرہ الم المرحور

Here we may point out that according to the decision of Shariat Court, an Ahmadi has been permitted to profess and practice his own religion.

ii) Two Ahmadies were accused for saying 'Azan'. They however arranged their bail before arrest.

iii) Two Ahmadies who had gone to see their relations who were under arrest, were detained at the Police Station for nothing. They were later on arrested on false accusation in a criminal case.

iv) The Ahmadies arrested for using badges of Kalima Tayyaba were mercilessly beaten in public.

v) The campaign for arresting the Ahmadies was started by the D.C. Tharparkar (Mr. Rasul Bux Baloch) on April 24, 1985. Uptill now not a single Ahmadi has been released on bail on one pretext or another under the direction of D.C. The bail applications are neither rejected nor accepted so as to keep them pending procedurally, even the bail of the pesons arrested under 107/117 Cr PC (Preventive measures) was rejected by Mukhtiarkar, under direction of D.C.

BADIN: The S.P., Badin, has threatened the local Ahmadies that in case they do not obey his order of removing Kalima Tayyaba from their Mosque all the Ahmadies including their women would be arrested.

The houses of respectable innocent Ahmadis were searched in Kunri, Mehmoodabad & Nasirabad at night time with heavy police and a scene of terror was created in the locality. The respected Ahmadis were arrested and humiliated. The house of District Amir of Ahmadiyya Jamaat (Dr. A.R. Siddiqui, practicing for the last 35 years in Mirpur Khas) was searched with heavy Police force including lady Police on the night between 25th & 26th April, 1985. His Clinic was also searched at night time in order to arrest and humiliate him in the eys of the citizens.

The Deputy Commissioner Tharparkar called Dr. A.R. Siddiqui and wanted to dictate illegal demands and ultimately threatened to arrest and further he created false accusations to justify his action.

2. REMOVAL OF KALIMA TAYYABA

i)Kalima Tayyaba has been removed by the SDM with the help of local police from Ahmadiyya Mosque, Drigh Road, twice. At first occasion 43 Ahmadies who had gathered to say their Tahajjud prayer were arrested while on the second occasion, 5 persons of Orangi Town, Liaquatabad and Golimar.

3. EXHUME OF DEAD BODY AFTER 7 DAYS

Even our dead bodies are not spared. In Orangi Town a dead body was exhumed after 7 days under the supervision of Magistrate and was burried at some unknown place.

REPORT OF THE TABLEEGH SEMINAR, PHILADELPHIA

Held at University of Pennsylvania's Commons building, Philadelphia, commencing with the recitation and translation of a chapter of the Holy Quran by Missionary Northeast Region, Inamul Haq Kauser. The Honorable Christian guests included ministers and pastors of churches from different parts of Pennsylvania, professors of Theology, Hebrew and the Bible, Doctors from different disciplines, students of religions, and members of parishes along with their wives. They were welcomed and seated in the relaxing atmosphere of the cafeteria. Prof. Dillard delivered a speech on the concept of prophethood in the Bible. He focused on the Old Testament. He theorized that Bible advocates the roles of prophets not only as communicators but as intermediaries as well. He suggested that Moses as well as other Biblical prophets performed the role of filling the breach between men and God when the wrath of God had been incited.

Pastor Ted Noe of the Presbytarian Evangelical Church spoke on redemption. He used a graphic representation of the relationship between man, sins and God.

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Prof. Loius Hammann of the Gettysburg College came all the way to deliver his famous speech on introduction to Ahmadiyyat. This speech was delivered by him at a special seminar on Ahmadiyyat that he had arranged at the annual meeting of the American academy of religions at Canton in May of this year. Prof. Hammann's speech was emotionally charged. His speech covered the history of Ahmadiyvat, the organizational structure of the Jamaat, the social and spiritual fabric of the members, the devotion and love between the members and Hazrat Amirul Momeneen. He then discussed the historical as well as the contemporary oppositions and persecutions.

Speakers with perceptions of the Jamaat and of Islam from an outside or previously-outside point of view can be presented to the non-Islamic audience with a positive reinforcing value.

The chief speaker of the program, Sheikh Mubarak Ahmad, Amir and Missionary Incharge, Ahmadiyya community in Islam, USA, thanked the audience for their interest in the exchange of religious understanding displayed by the Christians. Explaining the role of religion and its historical development, Shaikh Sahib, in a most affectionate note, described how Islam fulfilled the need that had been faced by mankind at its maturity. He then demonstrated how the prophecies in Deuteronomy were fulfilled through the advent of the greatest of the prophets, Hazrat Muhammad, eternal peace and blessings of Allah be upon him. He went on to invite the Christians who accepted the Biblical prophecies to accept the Holy Prophet of Islam also.

Sheikh Sahib in his ringing, appealing voice coming from the very depths of his heart, left no one in the audience without the least doubt that the prophet of Islam indeed was the promised prophet of the Bible. The invitation to Islam left a deep, profound impression on the Christian as well as the Ahmadi Muslim audience. he became ill and was not able to contribute actively to his task of writing, etc. Finally during the fourth year after this vision, Sir Zafrullah Khan passed away.

Sir Muhammad Z. Khan, 92 Pakistan Ex-Foreign Minister

ISLAMABAD, Pakistan. Sept. 1 (Reuters)—Sir Muhammad Zafrulla Khan, Pakistan's first Foreign Minister, died today after a long illness at the age of 92, the official press agency reported.

He was also a former president of the United Nations General Assembly and of the International Court of Justice at The Hague.

Sir Muhammad suffered an attack of bronchial pneumonia last month and had been in a coma for several days, the agency said.

He became Pakistan's Foreign Minister when the country was founded in 1947 after the partition
